LENTEN REGULATIONS

Each year the Lord Jesus calls the entire Church to a special season of penance and renewal. As we begin this holy time of Lent, we should reflect on our need for conversion of heart, prayer, charitable works and penance.

The season of Lent extends this year from Ash Wednesday, March 6, to the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, April 18, inclusive.

1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent.
2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed, The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one’s needs, but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices.
4. To completely disregard the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

LENTEN SEASON

- * The *Alleluia* is not sung or said during Lenten liturgies.
- * The *Gloria* is not sung or said during Lent except on the Solemnity of Saint Joseph (March 19) and the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord (March 25).
- * *Violet* is the color of the season. Pink of the fourth Sunday.
- * *Holy water* will be in the fonts. While Lent is a time for fasting, it is not a time to fast from our sacramentals. The Holy water is removed after the Evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday and replaced with the waters blessed at the Easter Vigil.

For these Forty Days we are conscious of how we must sharpen our senses and focus mind and heart on the Reign of God. We are, above all, aware of those waters in which we were baptized into Christ’s death. The waters of Baptism wait at Lent’s end for the catechumens, but we are called to renew our Baptism as well.

PRAYER AND REFLECTION

A word from Sr. Phyllis:

Three very important aspects of Lent are Prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We will be providing a variety of prayer forms and booklets that can help you during this season. In addition to what we provide, under the bulletin board you will find books donated to the parish. Feel free to borrow and return when you have read the book.

This Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, we will bless the Rice Bowls and hand them out to each family. That's a wonderful way to be aware of the needs throughout the world. Locally the Pantry has let us know they are in need of dried goods, cereals, Hamburger Helper, spaghetti, dried goods, etc. There will be a basket marked for that purpose ready to receive your donations.

Rather than a Spiritual Book Club this year we have a DVD club meeting which focuses on the Holy Spirit...the patroness of our parish. We have met three times during Advent and plan to complete this DVD Series on the Thursdays of lent at 4:30. If anyone would like to view the previous 3 sessions along with study guides, please be in touch. Everyone is welcome for the Lenten series. You need not have been present for the Advent sessions in order to attend the Lenten sessions.
