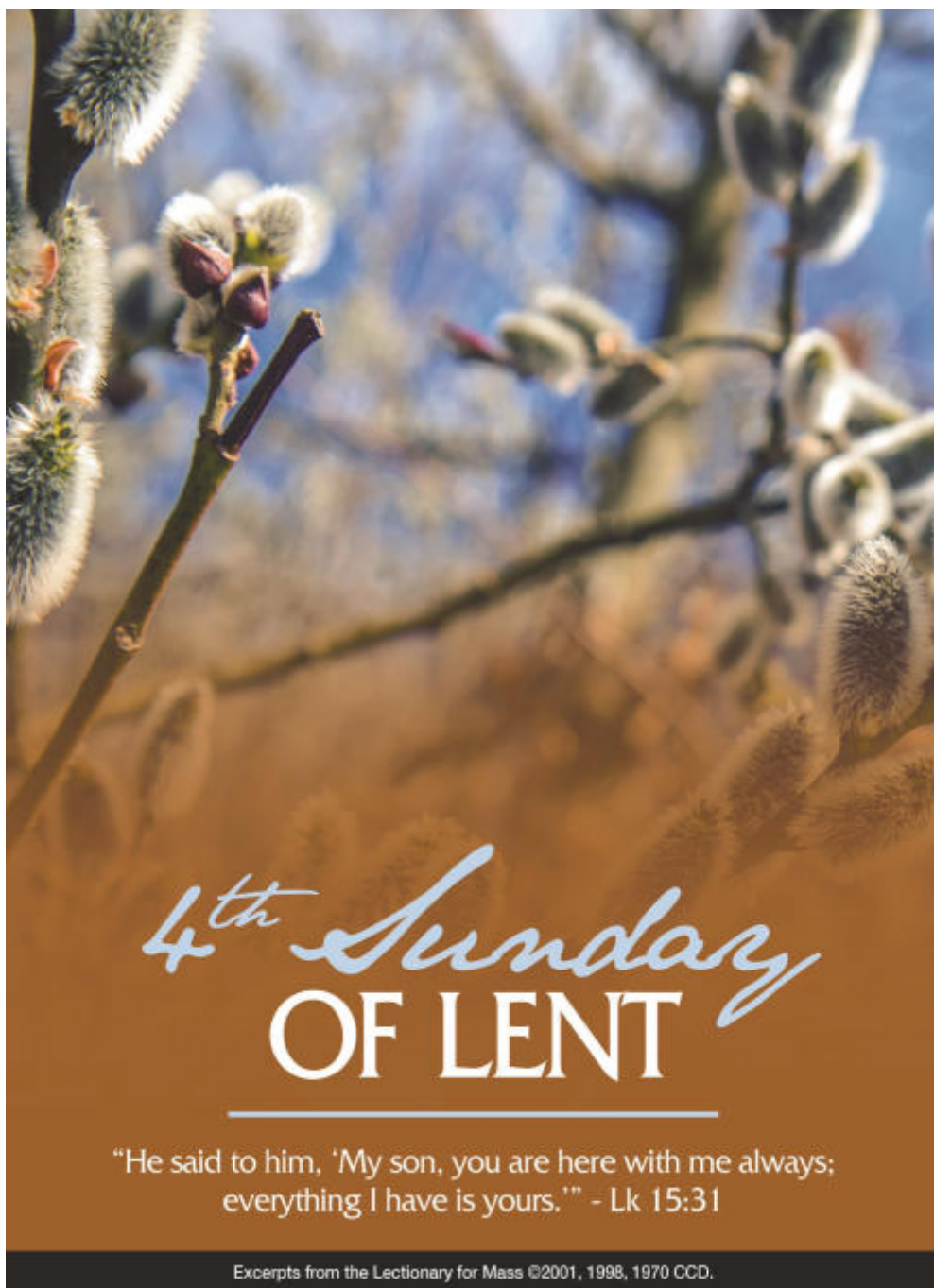

## A Word from Sr. Phyllis:

The first parish I led was one with an adopted parish in Haiti. Three times I accompanied parishioners so that we would not just send them money but would have a relationship with them. One of the most outstanding memories I have is of a school in Porta Prince run by a Belgian Priest, Fr. Bonan. He would go throughout the world begging food for the school, especially rice and beans. On the outside of the school was an image of the Sacred Heart. Above the door were the words, "First feed their bellies, then feed their mind." It's no different in our country than in Haiti. First feed their bellies, then feed their minds. Francie Schafer and I (especially Francie) wrote a grant for GUM-drops so that 1700 local children have food to eat on the weekend when the school lunch program is not available. The grant was through the Dominican Sister's Ministry Subsidy Program.
