PRAYER AND REFLECTION

A Word from Sr. Phyllis:

Once we turn the calendar to April it feels as if Easter is almost here. We will again this year have Seder on Palm Sunday but we will host it at 5:00 p.m., an hour early. That way anyone who wants to attend Seder and the moving enactment of the Stations of the Cross enacted out by the OLMC/Holy Spirit youth group could attend both. The Seder will be at 5:00 p.m. /Stations of the Cross will be at the OLMC Church at 7:30 p.m. There will be a sign-up sheet on the give-away table so we know how many to plan for. Remember, we share potluck in the midst of the Seder.

One more reminder about Palm Sunday: Because we bless palms with the Christian Church and the United Methodist Church, we will begin a half hour early on April 14 so that we will be finished at the regular time.

Again this year we are planning to have a Parish Spring Cleaning Day at the Church. We will meet at 9:00 a.m. and hope to be finished by noon on Saturday, April 13th. There will be a list of possibilities you might volunteer to do. A light lunch will be served as we finish up.

The Easter Vigil begins at 8:00 p.m. on April 20th. Fr. Joseph Brown will be with us for Holy Week; Fr. Mohr will be with us for Easter Sunday morning. We will baptize Gabriel Leco and his little sister, Luna at the Easter Vigil. Since Gabriel is 9 years old, he will complete the Sacraments of Initiation with Confirmation and First Eucharist. There will be a celebration afterwards to celebrate.

One always knew she wanted to be a shining woman in her community — and an example to her two daughters. She studied hard and earned her teaching degree from a university. But in Gaza, jobs are hard to find. Even though Ona had good grades, she could not find work as a teacher. "I started to feel hopeless," she says.

That's why CRS matches workers with job opportunities. Through CRS, Ona applied for a teaching internship. She took the knowledge and confidence she gained from the internship—plus some of her income—and opened a tutoring center. Now, she helps students of all ages with their studies. After only 1 month, Ona's center has served 41 children.

"CRS helped me start." Ona says. "They gave me the chance. Now I will be able to continue this on my own."

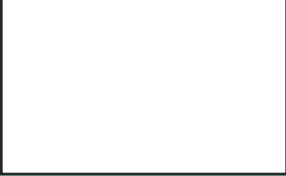

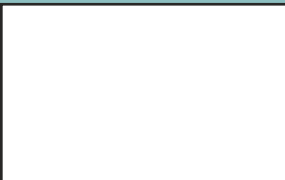

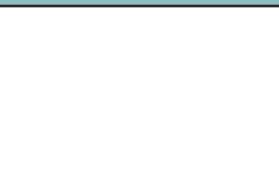
