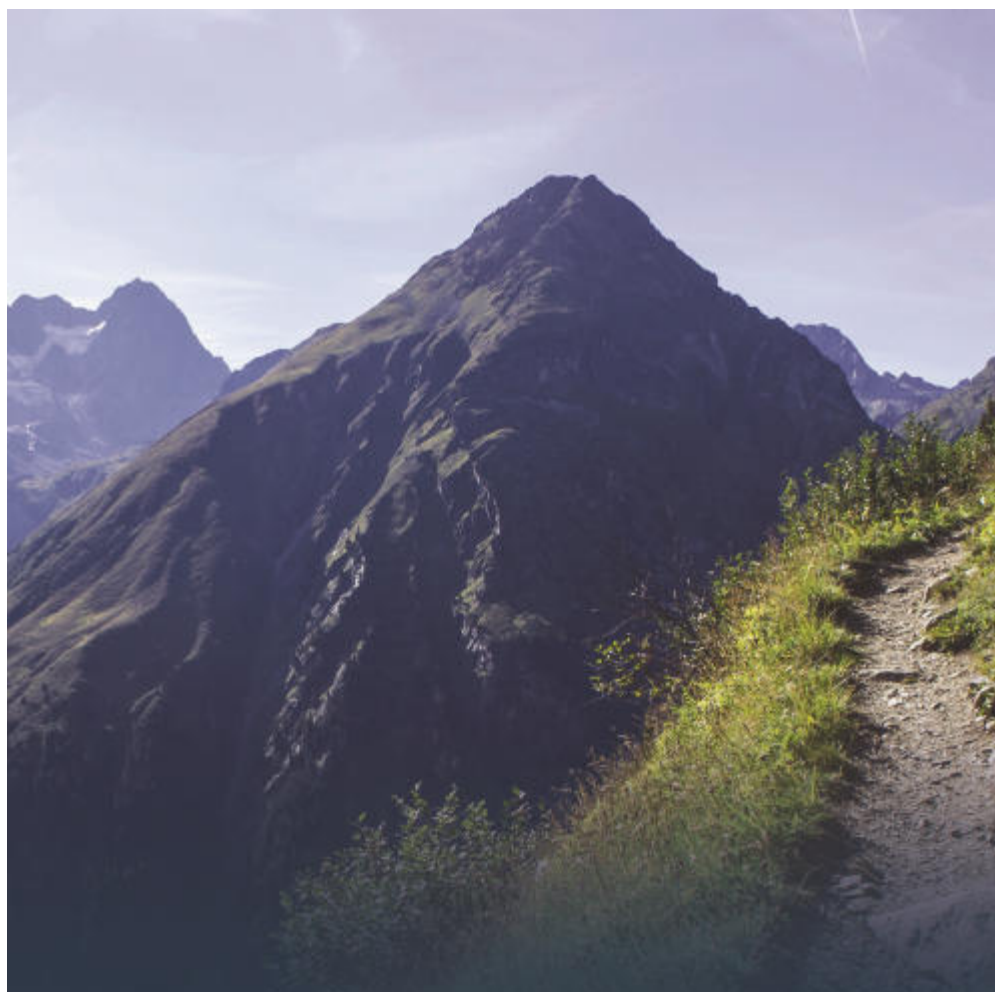

The Newman Center patron, Blessed John Henry Newman, saw before most others that the sacred world and the secular world were becoming more separate in modern life, especially in higher education. As a young Anglican priest and Oxford faculty member, Newman had been a leading figure in the Oxford Movement, which urged the Anglican Church to reform itself and return to many Catholic beliefs and practices. Newman was a well-known and controversial figure before his conversion; he wrote many books, sermons, letters, and poems and had a large following. His conversion was quite a shock to English society, and he had to leave his position on the Oxford faculty.

On October 13 of this year, Pope Francis will canonize John Henry Newman; he will be recognized as a saint throughout the Catholic Church, and his feast day will be October 9th, the anniversary of his conversion to Roman Catholicism in 1845.
