KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

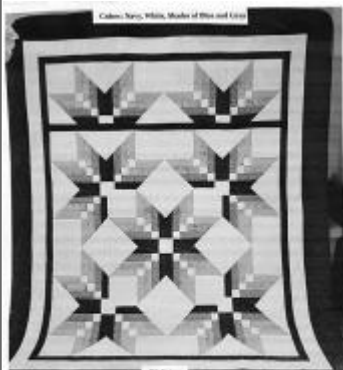
The Knights will be conducting a fundraising raffle to support our priests of tomorrow. This project is conducted throughout all of Illinois and goes from September to November.

A Word from Jennifer Flath, CRE:

We are happy to begin our PSR year today! It'll be great to see all the children once again. Some are joining us in person, while others are learning virtually. We plan to be as flexible as we can this year, as each family is navigating this COVID situation in a different way. What's most important is that we're able to share God's work and God's love with the children, and help them as they continue their faith journeys.

As you may recall, last year's PSR classes came to an abrupt end when COVID arrived in Illinois. We've talked with leaders in Belleville, and worked with others within the diocese to craft a plan that works (as much as anything works right now). We've completed all the sacramental celebrations for last year's classes, and although it may have looked a bit different, the effect is the same and we're so proud of those students and happy for them. It's also important to keep things moving for the rest of the students who are preparing for their own sacramental celebrations, so, on we go.....

Our schedule for the first semester, or at least until Advent, will consist of in-person classes on the first Sunday of the month, and remote learning the other weeks. Parents have agreed to take on the responsibility of sharing lessons with their children—and we are so grateful! The students will receive books and other supplies this weekend, and if they're learning remotely we'll make arrangements to get them delivered.
