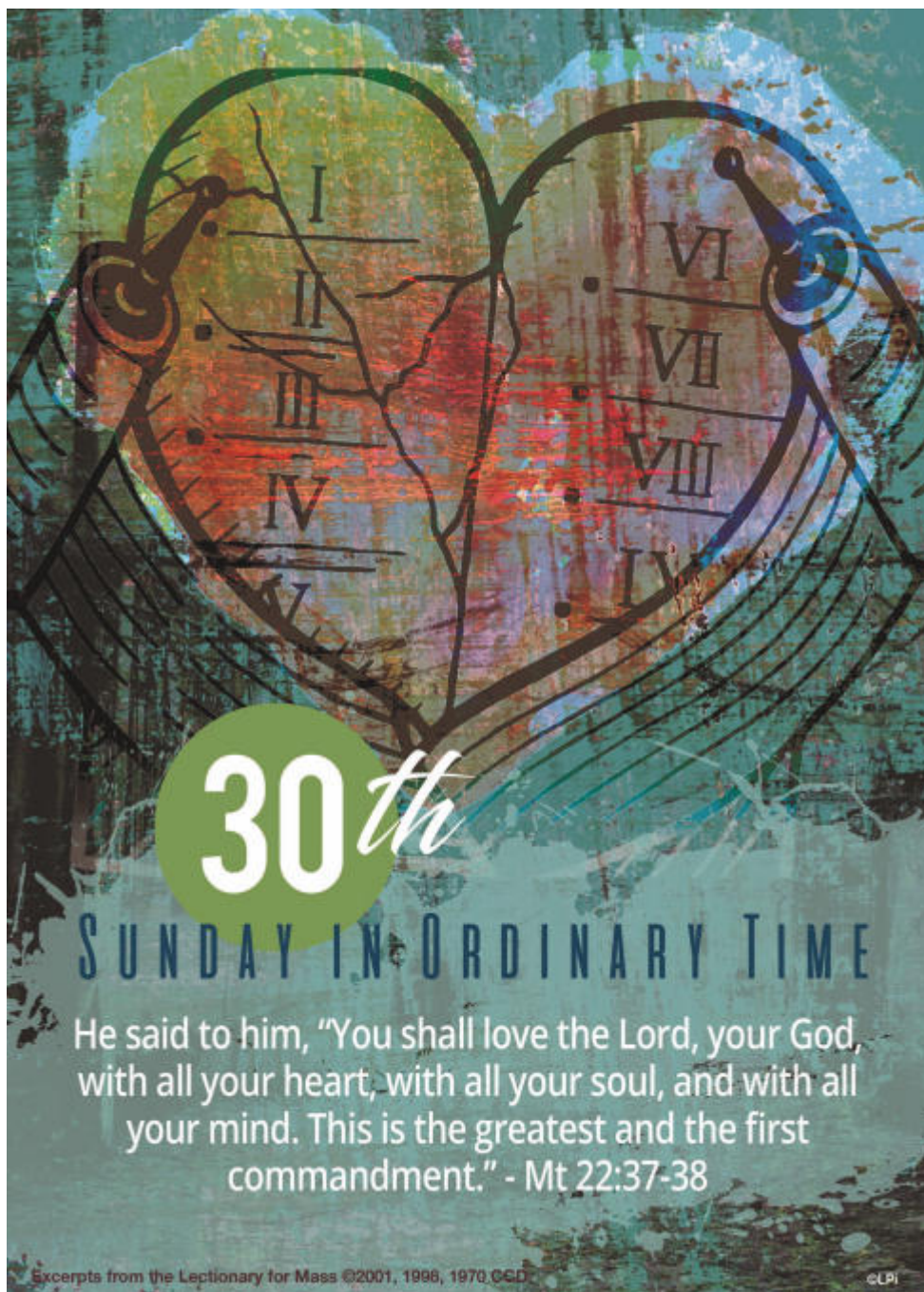

A Word from Sr. Phyllis:

The Women's Group in involving our parish in the "Box of Joy" Drive to make sure "the poorest of the poor" children receive gifts for Christmas. The Cross Catholic Outreach (CCO) created the Box of Joy project to show the love of Jesus. Children in 7 countries (Haiti, Guatemala, Dominican Republic, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Jamaica and Grenada) receive these gift boxes packed with presents like small toys, bar soap, pencils, notebooks, toothbrush, toothpaste, hard candy, t-shirt, etc. We are hoping with the help of parishioners to fill 20 boxes. Each box is designated for either a boy or girl of differing ages. Fill the box with items from a list found on the table with the boxes. Add a personal Christmas card from your family or a picture of your family in the box. Each box costs \$9.00 in postage for shipping. After you fill your box, secure with a rubber band (no tape) and include a \$9.00 check (no cash) in the provided envelope and place on top of the gifts. The boxes need to be dropped off the week of November 7. You can drop them off at the Newman Center (SIU) or off at the parish and Betty Schnake will deliver. Boxes can be found on the South West table in the hall. If you find extra room in your box, feel free to add some of the items already donated for this project located on the same table as the boxes.
