Our heartfelt thanks to Francie Shafer who wrote for a CSMA grant. We were awarded a \$487 grant to purchase new technology equipment for the church and parish hall. This will include microphones, a wireless body pack and cables that will enable our sound system to be compatible between the church and the hall.
