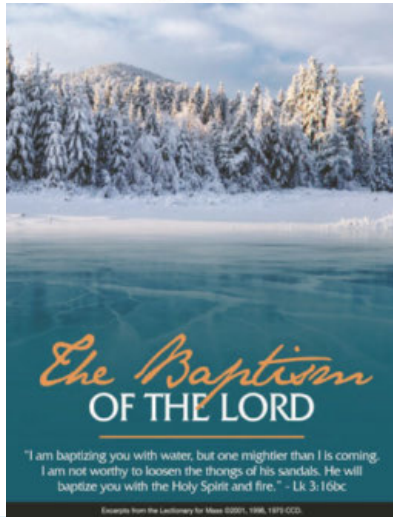

PASTORAL CARE

Christian Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after a preparation class (for the first child only) through the parish (call the parish office at 920-468-0595 to schedule). Baptisms are usually not celebrated in Lent.

Sacramental Reconciliation

Saturday: 3:30-3:50 pm or by appointment. Communal celebrations are offered during Advent & Lent.

Holy Eucharist

If you are sick, homebound, or in a nursing home and would like to have Communion brought to you, please call the parish office at 920-468-0595.

Confirmation

Confirmation is celebrated for High School Students in the spring of the Junior year, after appropriate preparation for our students of Preble HS, Luxemburg-Casco HS & Notre Dame Academy. Adult parishioners will go through a separate process with Confirmation sometime around Easter.

Christian Marriage

Christian Marriage is celebrated for couples who demonstrate an active practice of the Catholic faith. We request nine months of advance notice for complete preparation.

Sacrament of the Sick

If you are anticipating a hospital stay and desire this sacrament, or in case of an emergency, please call the rectory at 468-0595. The Sacrament of the Sick is celebrated communally during Advent & Lent.
