## The Baptism of the Lord

This weekend, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. When most of us think of a baptism, we may just think about the water that is poured over the heads of those being baptized. Of course, that is one of the key components of baptism.



Another important component, that sometimes gets overlooked in the remembrance of our baptism however, is the baptismal candle. In the baptism rite, the priest or deacon presiding at the baptism, takes a light from the Easter candle and presents it to the parents/godparents with these words, "Receive the light of Christ, Parents and godparents, this light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. This child of yours has been enlightened by Christ. They are to walk always as a child of the light."

Robert Lewis Stevenson, as a boy, was looking out the window watching a workman one day come by and light the gas lights along the street. When asked what he was watching, the young boy said, "I see a man making holes in the darkness."

If we look at the headlines or turn on our television, we cannot help but notice the darkness that fills our world today. We are reminded of how important it is for us in today's world to "walk always as a child of the light".

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, I would like you to take a moment or two to reflect on your own baptism and the reception of the light of Christ that your parents/godparents accepted for you that day and ask yourself these questions:  
Do I continue to walk as child of light?  
Do I reflect the light of Christ in our darkened world today?

Imagine if we could, for even just a day or two, reflect the light of Christ that we received in our baptism to our families, our community and our world. We could certainly help to make a difference by bringing the light and the Gospel message of Christ to those around us. Hopefully somebody may even look at our lives and say "I see those people sharing the light of Christ and making holes in the darkness."

Go out and celebrate the Baptism of the Lord by letting God's light shine through you!

## Gospel Reading for Jan. 16

John 2:1-11

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding.

When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine."

And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you."

Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons.

## KNOWING YOUR CATHOLIC FAITH WITH DEACON JIM

This weekend in the church we celebrate the **Baptism of the Lord**. I wanted to share with you some of the common questions about the **Sacrament of Baptism in the Catholic Church** and answers to those questions.

### Who can receive a Catholic baptism?

Anyone who has not already been baptized can receive the sacrament of Baptism in the Catholic Church. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that "Every person not yet baptized and only such a person is able to be baptized," (CCC 1246). Baptism leaves an *indelible* (permanent) mark on the soul. There are no age restrictions for baptism; you cannot be too old or too young to be baptized.

### Who can perform a Catholic baptism?

Anyone can perform a baptism, however this is typically done only in extreme cases in which someone's life is in danger. The Catholic Church has *ordinary ministers* for sacraments and those are bishops, priests, and deacons. An ordinary minister is one who has been entrusted with the authority to perform the sacrament. Most baptisms are done by a priest or deacon, but there are extreme cases when even an unbaptized person can baptize someone. All that is required is "the will to do what the Church does when she baptizes, and to apply the Trinitarian Baptismal formula—which is, "I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

### Does the Catholic Church accept baptisms from another church?

Yes, the Catholic Church recognizes any baptism that uses water and in which the baptized was baptized with the words "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

### Can someone receive the Grace of Baptism without being baptized?

Yes, those who die for their faith but were never baptized receive the grace of baptism by blood. This is often called martyrdom – being killed for your faith and never compromising it. Also, those truly seeking baptism, but are unable to receive it due to extenuating circumstances can receive it by desire. If the person has an explicit desire for baptism and is repentant of their sins then they will be "baptized."
