



A NOTE FROM FR. LUKE

GOOD NEWS



I'd like to share two pieces of good news with you about the heating and cooling system at St. Ignatius School and Holy Cross Church. I pass on this news because the needs of our parishes' buildings and grounds affect all of us, especially the needs of the school building, which is part of our future in working with young families.

First, we are the recipients of two grants from the Diocese of Green Bay! The Catholic Foundation, through the one by One Campaign, is giving us a grant of \$200,000 from the fund for Catholic School material improvements. And we will receive \$235,000 from the Bishop's Greatest Needs Fund. These grants are gifts that do not have to be repaid. In these two grants, we have received \$435,000 towards our \$1.7 million goal for the heating and cooling for St. Ignatius School and Holy Cross Church.

Second, we have received initial approval from Bishop Ricken to proceed with this improvement plan. Because each parish is a legal corporation of the State of Wisconsin, and the Bishop is the president of that parish corporation, we need his approval for any major plan. Our plan was reviewed by the Bishop's two facilities and financial committees, and also a group called the College of Consultors which works with the Bishop. All these groups have given us the green light to proceed.

Through these grants and approvals, and with your generous donations and pledges made to St. Ignatius School and Holy Cross Church, we have very close to \$1.2 million towards our \$1.7 million goal. We have more work to be done, but meanwhile we can celebrate and thank God for these two grants and the Bishop's approval.


NOVEMBER 26

(Matthew 25:31-46)

Jesus said to his disciples: "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit upon his glorious throne, and all the nations will be assembled before him. And he will separate them one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?' And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.' Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.' Then they will answer and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?' He will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me. And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."
