



Worship Column

First Saturdays Devotion

Once a month, you may have noticed in the front-page bulletin schedule that there is a "1st Saturday Mass" at 8:00 am in Baileys Harbor. It is usually preceded with prayer of the Rosary and then after Mass, confessions are offered. You may have wondered what this is about.

Beginning in 1915, Our Lady Mary started appearing to three young children at Fatima, Portugal. In an apparition in July 1917, Our Lady had indicated that she would request a devotion involving the First Saturdays of the months. This request was made on December 10, 1925, when Lucia, one of the three children, was a novice among the Dorothean Sisters. On that day, Sr. Lucia experienced an apparition of the Virgin Mary and the Child Jesus, in which Mary said:

"All those who during five months, on the first Saturday, go to confession, receive Holy Communion, say a rosary and keep me company for fifteen minutes, meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the rosary for the intention of making reparation to me, I promise to assist them at the hour of death, with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls" (*Documents on Fatima & the Memoirs of Sister Lucia*, 279-280).

Hence, the Five First Saturdays Devotion:

- 1. Go to confession (within 8 days before or after reception of Communion)
- 2. Receive Holy Communion (within 24 hrs of 1st Saturday)
- 3. Say five decades of the rosary
- 4. Keep Mary company for fifteen minutes meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the rosary

Consider participating in this devotion offered at Stella Maris guided by our patron Mary. What a blessing she has offered us to be there at the hour of death with special graces if we just take some time to pray with her for five consecutive Saturdays.
