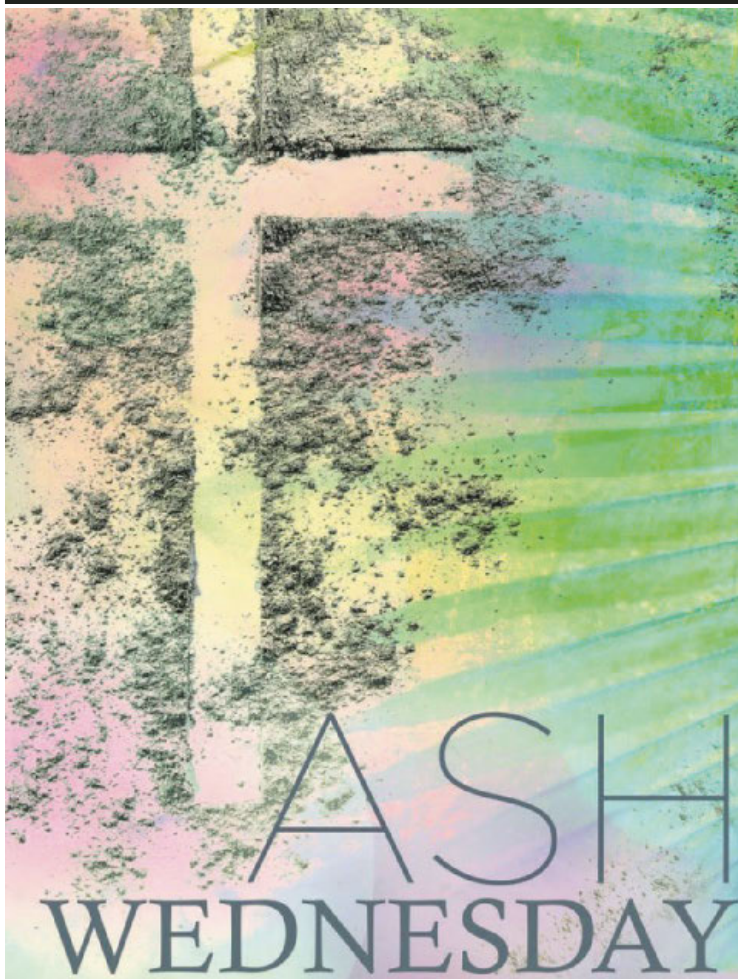
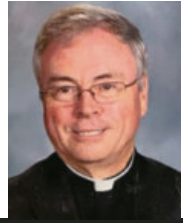

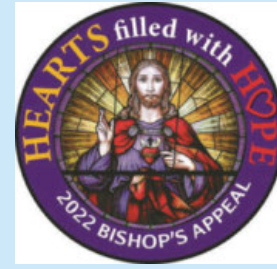

April 27th...Only 2 Months Away!



On November 14th the Confirmation retreat was held for our fifteen confirmation students. It was on that day at all the masses a prayer was offered to all parishioners to pray for these confirmation candidates. I hope you picked one up! With their confirmation date only two months away, April 27th, I am offering another prayer for them. This prayer was printed on Holy Cards which was given to all fifteen students at the retreat (prayer pronoun changes to reflect our 15 students). I am again asking you to say this prayer: "Prayer for the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit." These gifts will give students an increased ability to practice their Catholic faith in every aspect of their lives and to witness Christ in every situation.

O Lord Jesus Christ Who, before ascending into heaven did promise to send the Holy Spirit to finish Your work in the souls of Your Apostles and Disciples, deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to (our 15 Confirmation students) that He may perfect in (their souls), the work of Your grace and Your love. Grant them the **Spirit of Wisdom** so they may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after things that are eternal, the **Spirit of Understanding** to enlighten their minds with light of Your divine truth, the **Spirit of Counsel** that they may ever choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven, the **Spirit of Fortitude** that they may bear their cross with You and that they may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose their salvation, The **Spirit of Knowledge** that they may know God and know themselves and grow perfect in the science of the Saints, the **Spirit of Piety** that they may find the service to God sweet and amiable and the **Spirit of Fear of the Lord** that they may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him. Respect Life

Human rights organizations estimate that there are 25 million victims of human trafficking worldwide. While we live in a place that seems far away from these issues, the reality is that it can and does happen everywhere. This modern-day slavery has victims in sexual exploitation and forced labor in manufacturing, agriculture, domestic homes, hospitality and more. While certain factors can make some more vulnerable to trafficking, there is no "typical" profile. These victims aren't just those living in poverty or without access to education—they come from all walks of life.*

At a "Walking with Mom's in Need" Diocesan conference held last month, we heard of the connection of trafficking to the foster care system from Tori Petersen (a former foster youth and trafficking survivor). She gave the staggering figure that 60% of human trafficking involves the foster care system and that 99% are trafficked by people they know and trusted.

On the February 8th, Day of Prayer and Awareness against Human Trafficking, we prayed our rosary intentions against this horrific crime. Our reflections called us to "awaken to realities around us, to be aware of the suffering of our many sisters and brothers....treated as objects/commodities to be bought and sold". This crime grows because there is demand—we must pray and search our hearts for ways to stop this. Support our faith formation, programs for youth and young families and know the supply chain source of products you buy. Read more on things to watch for and others ways you can help.*

Worship Column

The Word: This Sunday’s Gospel speaks of how a good person has a store of goodness; additionally, in the Book of Wisdom, “one’s speech discloses the bent of one’s mind.” In the Psalm we are reminded to bear good fruit in our lives and in the 2nd reading, Paul encourages us to “be firm, steadfast, always fully devoted to the work of the Lord.” And, ultimately, we, with Christ, are victorious! “Death is swallowed up in victory.”



The Meditation: We, as good trees, “branch out” and reach other people in our lives. What is the fruit? Good works, the virtues, or our spiritual presence in the world? “But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.” (James 3:17) In our daily lives, we are living out our devotedness to the work of the Lord. Our presence in the world is evidence of the Resurrected Christ—the Living God! That is why we hold the victory!

Liturgy into Action: If you were to change one thing about yourself, what would it be? Our spiritual life depends upon our hard work at self-reflection and really praying for divine assistance. Some of us journal, some walk and pray, others sit quietly perhaps gazing at a crucifix or other visual representation of Christ or those that reflect his image (a saint, for example). I say that it’s hard work because we really prefer thinking of ourselves as being just fine as we are. But if we want to inherit the kingdom we must “sell all that we have.” What things in our life experiences need to be tweaked or “pruned?” Let’s ask the Holy Spirit to shine light upon our condition.

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the kickoff to Lent. A friend of mine once said, “I love the time of Lent!” “Why?” I asked, dreadingly thinking of the time of fasting. “Because the Lord has given me so many graces in my life during Lent!” No matter what we give, the Lord outdoes our “generosity” many times over in his reaching out to us as a Good Shepherd with what we need on our journey.

Prayer: Lord, we thank you and your Holy Spirit that we hear your word and thereby desire to be so connected to you that we would like to be as a tree bearing good fruit. Through the intercession of St. Casimir, so devoted to your Holy Mother, we pray that we may be directed by your fatherly hand to become better people. Amen.

Note: St. Casimir, patron saint of Lithuania, Poland and Russia is credited with the hymn, “Daily, Daily Sing to Mary,” because, as the story goes, a copy of the hymn was found underneath the pillow which his head was resting on at his departure from this world. It seems that he was not the author of it, but it shows the depth of his devotion to Mary.
