Biblical Brainteaser

Solutions

I once made a **remark** about the hidden books of the Bible. It was a **lulu**; **kept** people **looking** so hard for **facts**... and for others it was a **revelation**. Some were in a **jam**, especially since the names of the books were not capitalized. But the **truth** finally struck home to **numbers** of our readers. To others it was a real **job**. We want it to be a **most** fascinating few moments for you. **Yes, there** will be some really easy ones to spot. Others may require **judges** to help them. I will quickly **admit it** usually takes a minister to find one of them, and there will be loud **lamentations** when it is found. A little lady says **she brews** a cup of tea so she can concentrate better. See how well you can **compete**. **Rest assured**, for there really are sixteen names of books of the Bible in this paragraph.

Respect Life

Recently, some pro-abortion groups received attention for their vandalism to Catholic Churches, bombings of pro-life offices and intimidation tactics against Supreme Court Justices over the possible reversal of Roe v. Wade. This behavior shows some of the fruits of the abortion world under the guise of helping women-- destruction, violence and fear. But, conversely, there was recent news of someone's passing who has impacted the world in a much more uplifting way...someone whose fruits were healing, love and hope.

On April 20, Vicki Thorn passed away. Thorn was the founder of Project Rachel, the first post-abortion healing ministry that started in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee in 1984 and is now worldwide. At a Diocesan event for respect life leaders, Thorn shared how she had great empathy for a close friend shattered by her abortion. "This was a very painful experience for her and she was an emotional mess...All I could do was love her and be present to her". Seeing the enormous footprint abortion left on her friend's life was life-changing to Thorn. It inspired her to study the psychological and physiological effects of abortion in order to counsel others to a place of healing and she gave us great witness on how to walk with others.

In prayer Thorn asked God for guidance to help women (and men) in their grief and opening her Bible she read Jeremiah 31:15, "**Rachel is weeping for her children; she refuses to be comforted for her children, because they are no more.**"...And then reading the next verses, was inspired to found Project Rachel: "**Keep your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears...there is hope for your future declares the Lord...**" Project Rachel (www.hopeafterabortion.com) can be lifesaving for women who are struggling with feelings of anxiety, depression, alcohol /drug abuse and suicidal behaviors after abortion. We urge anyone struggling to reach out...you are loved and not alone!

Worship Column

June 5, 2022: Pentecost



The Word: “Jesus said to his disciples: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always.”
(John 14:15)

The Meditation: Jesus Christ, the giver of the ultimate gift of love, his own self in the sacrifice of his body and blood and in the giving of his very own spirit to his beloved followers. Think of the advocate, the teacher, the healer and guide that we have within us! This is all that we need to “go to the finish line” and become one with our Lord and welcomed by him into the heavenly kingdom!

Liturgy into Action: After being called, we have the hard work to do. It is the work of clothing ourselves with virtue (taking a hard look at what we really are), receiving the sacraments (worship & praise, Eucharist, repentance & forgiveness, and blessings untold through the other sacraments), praying “without ceasing” and being bearers of the Light to the world around us. *During June, we will be prayerfully reviewing our heartfelt commitment to stewardship. This should not overburden us, but with humility and confidence we offer up our time, treasure and talents for the good of the Church. Then, in late June, all volunteer ministers are invited to attend a Ministry Workshop. Finally, this summer, parish leaders and all parishioners will be invited to take a deep look at how we live the Great Commission, “Go and make disciples of all nations...”*

A Long Prayer: “Oh Holy Spirit, You are the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. You are the Spirit of truth, love and holiness, proceeding from the Father and the Son and equal to Them in all things. I adore You and love You with all my heart. Teach me to know and to seek God, by whom and for whom I was created. Fill my heart with a holy fear and a great love for Him. Give me compunction and patience and do not let me fall into sin.

Increase faith, hope and charity in me and bring forth in me all the virtues proper to my state of life. Help me to grow in the four cardinal virtues, Your seven gifts and Your twelve fruits.

Make me a faithful follower of Jesus, an obedient child of the Church and a help to my neighbor. Give me the grace to keep the commandments and to receive the sacraments worthily. Raise me to holiness in the state of life to which You have called me and lead me through a happy death to everlasting life. Through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.
