Respect Life

Life is good! But how much do we value this incredible gift from God? Our faith teaches that we are made unique by God in His image and thereby have great innate dignity and worth. Our lives all have a common sharing in humanity—God lovingly gave us life, affording us the freedom to live life fully from conception to our natural end and we then protect this right for all others, recognizing the sanctity in each human life. This allows freedom for all to live in hope and we strive to support one another.

Unfortunately, society works to fray and manipulate our connection with our Creator and one another--to have us believe conditions must be set to ensure individual freedom. Our common humanity is threatened and we see each other not as unique individuals created by God, but instead as rivals against our own wants and needs. We even then write laws to promote our own judgements as to when or how we should decide who is worth protecting based on changing perimeters, which sadly gives our freedom away and leaves some unprotected based on who is in power.

Pope John Paul II wrote in <u>The Gospel of Life</u> "freedom negates and destroys itself and becomes a factor leading to the destruction of others, when it no longer recognizes and respects its essential link with the truth. When freedom, out of a desire to emancipate itself from all forms of tradition and authority, shuts out even the most obvious evidence of an objective and universal truth, which is the foundation of personal and social life, then the person ends up by no longer taking as the sole and indisputable point of reference for his own choices the truth about good and evil, but only his subjective and changeable opinion or, indeed, his selfish interest and whim." (Evangelium Vitae, 1995, 19)

Do You Speak Stewardship?



If you are married, I'm guessing that you know the best way to break bad news to your spouse, whether you realize it or not. Maybe it's simply that you know not to talk about the budget after your wife's football team has lost. Maybe you know your husband will take the news that your sister is coming to stay a little easier if you tell him over his favorite dinner. We do the same thing with our children, our friends, our coworkers — we have all learned the language of the people we love.

The truth is the same in every language, but it's important for us to convey that truth graciously. That's what Pentecost teaches us. The gift of being able to speak in tongues afforded the Apostles a practical skill to spread the Gospel message, but it also served as a powerful symbol of the importance of effective communication. Evangelization can only happen when you're speaking in words a person is able, ready and willing to hear.

Let's ask ourselves: what is the language we need to speak to share the truth with the person who is standing in front of us? Is it the language of quality time? The language of concern? The language of laughter and friendship? The language of authenticity, of plain talk and frankness?

The Holy Spirit gave the Apostles the ability to speak in tongues and it seems miraculous when we read about it in the Gospels — but only consider that we all have this same ability, in a certain way. The Holy Spirit can and will show us how to speak the truth, if we only ask.




