

The History


Throughout the year the Christ Child Society of Door County's helps underserved children. Part of a national organization, the local group has been active for the past 21 years. Assisting with the needs of children in our community has been a time of discovery, beginning with the iconic layette provided to new mothers who have no means of providing the necessary items at a child's birth.

Over the years the goals in aiding the underserved have broadened. Members have been reading and providing copies of books to underserved children attending pre-school. We have provided grant money for college training to young mothers who wish to improve their earning power, as well as providing elementary and high school students with Back To School funding. We have assisted with lunch payments for students in our schools, offered assistance to families with food during the holidays, and supported art/reading/drama opportunities for children. Referrals for specific help come from authorized personnel within our county.

Saint of the Month



Saint Henry was born in 972 to Henry, Duke of Bavaria, Germany, and his wife Gisela of Burgundy. Saint Henry's early life was permeated with Christianity, among those who guided his education was Bishop Wolfgang of Ratisbon, who became a saint himself. In 995, Saint Henry succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria and in 1002, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected emperor. In 1014, Saint Henry undertook the long journey from Germany to Rome to be crowned Holy Roman Emperor by Pope Benedict XIII.

In 1022 Saint Henry assisted Pope Benedict VIII in holding the Council of Pavia, which promoted clerical celibacy and sought to end simony (the buying and selling of ecclesiastical goods and offices). During his reign, Saint Henry used his wealth and position for the Church. He confirmed Benedict's authority over Rome, was a patron of churches and monasteries, supported the Cluniac Reforms, restored episcopal sees and founded the Diocese of Bamberg where he built a cathedral.

Saint Henry was married to Cunigunde of Luxembourg, to whom he was incredibly devoted. Although disputed by some historians, some stories of the couple's marriage report they took vows of chastity because their union was childless.

Saint Henry died in July of 1024 and was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III.



Worship Column

The Word: “Response” to Psalm 19, the optional Psalm for the 15th Sunday

“Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life.”

Meditation:

“For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.” (Hebrews 4:12) Since we have experienced that one, true God, through His word, we also grow in our knowledge and love of God, thus fulfilling the First Commandment.

Liturgy into Action: By receiving Him in the Holy Eucharist, we have such a closeness to Him that we live in Him and He in us, on the condition that we keep His word, that we stay awake, spiritually and lean on Him. Therefore, His Word is in us! Through Christ in us, we hold the truth, the living Word that can pierce through falsehoods and expel untruths and lies.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, on “Christ-The Unique Word of Sacred Scripture, paragraphs 102-104, reads: “Through all the words of Sacred Scripture, God speaks only one single Word, his one Utterance in whom he expresses himself completely:64

You recall that one and the same Word of God extends throughout Scripture, that it is one and the same Utterance that resounds in the mouths of all the sacred writers, since he who was in the beginning God with God has no need of separate syllables; for he is not subject to time.65

For this reason, the Church has always venerated the Scriptures as she venerates the Lord's Body. She never ceases to present to the faithful the bread of life, taken from the one table of God's Word and Christ's Body.66 In Sacred Scripture, the Church constantly finds her nourishment and her strength, for she welcomes it not as a human word, "but as what it really is, the word of God". 67 "In the sacred books, the Father who is in heaven comes lovingly to meet his children and talks with them."68

Prayer: “Heavenly Father, we praise you and bless you for your Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ. May you continue to bless us with Your Holy Word and fill us with your love and Holy Spirit so that we may better imitate Him and serve you in meaningful ways both at worship and amongst our neighbors. Amen.” “Hail, Mary, full of grace. . .”
