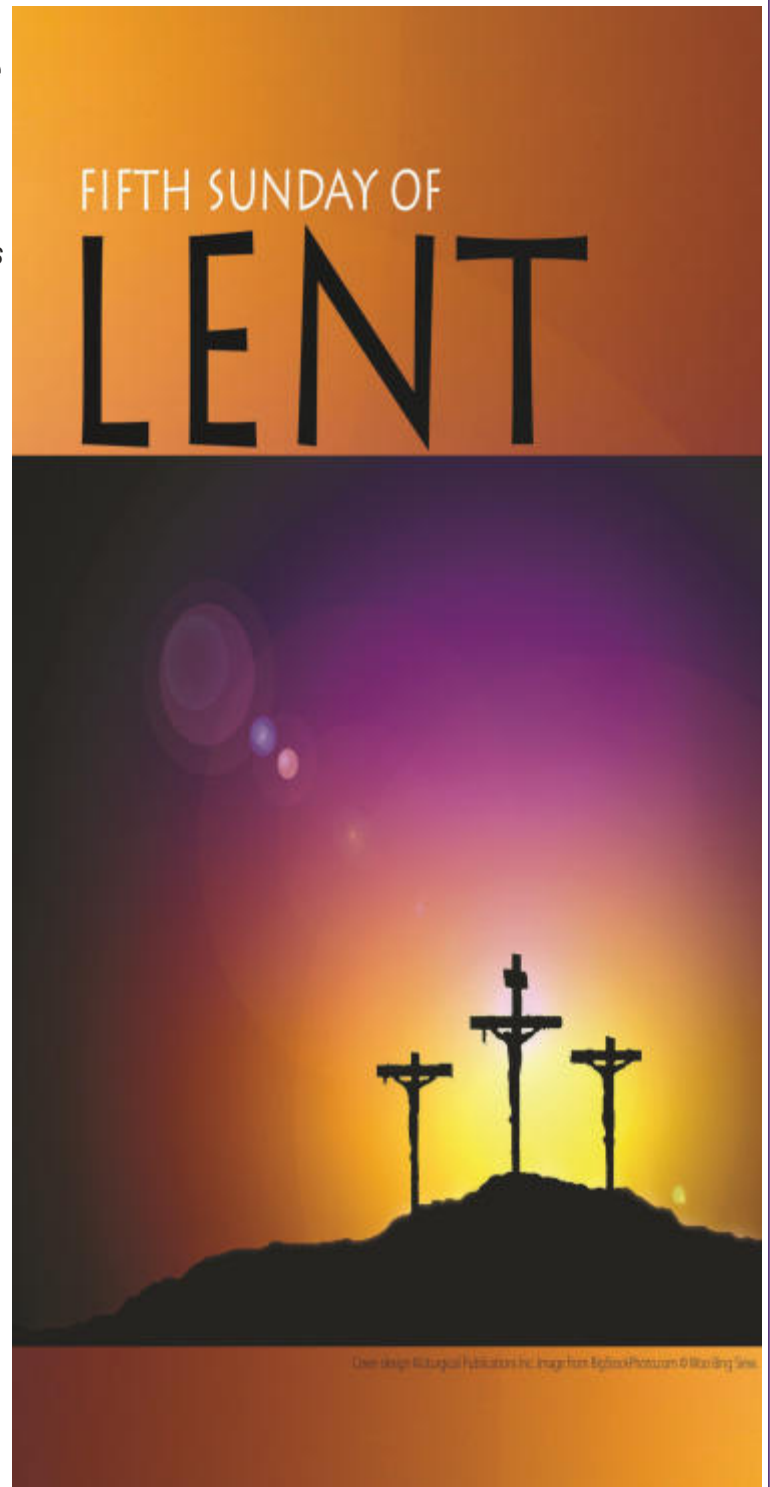

THIRD SCRUTINY

The words of the hymn, "I Now Live," echo faintly in churches still decorated for lent as the Third Scrutiny takes place and those who journey toward Easter hear about the raising of Lazarus. 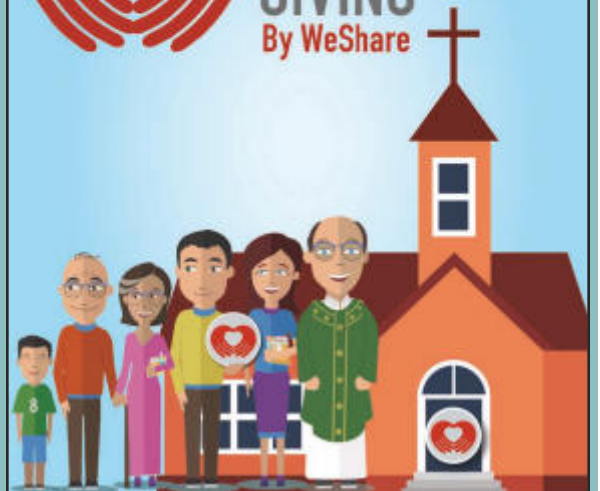
