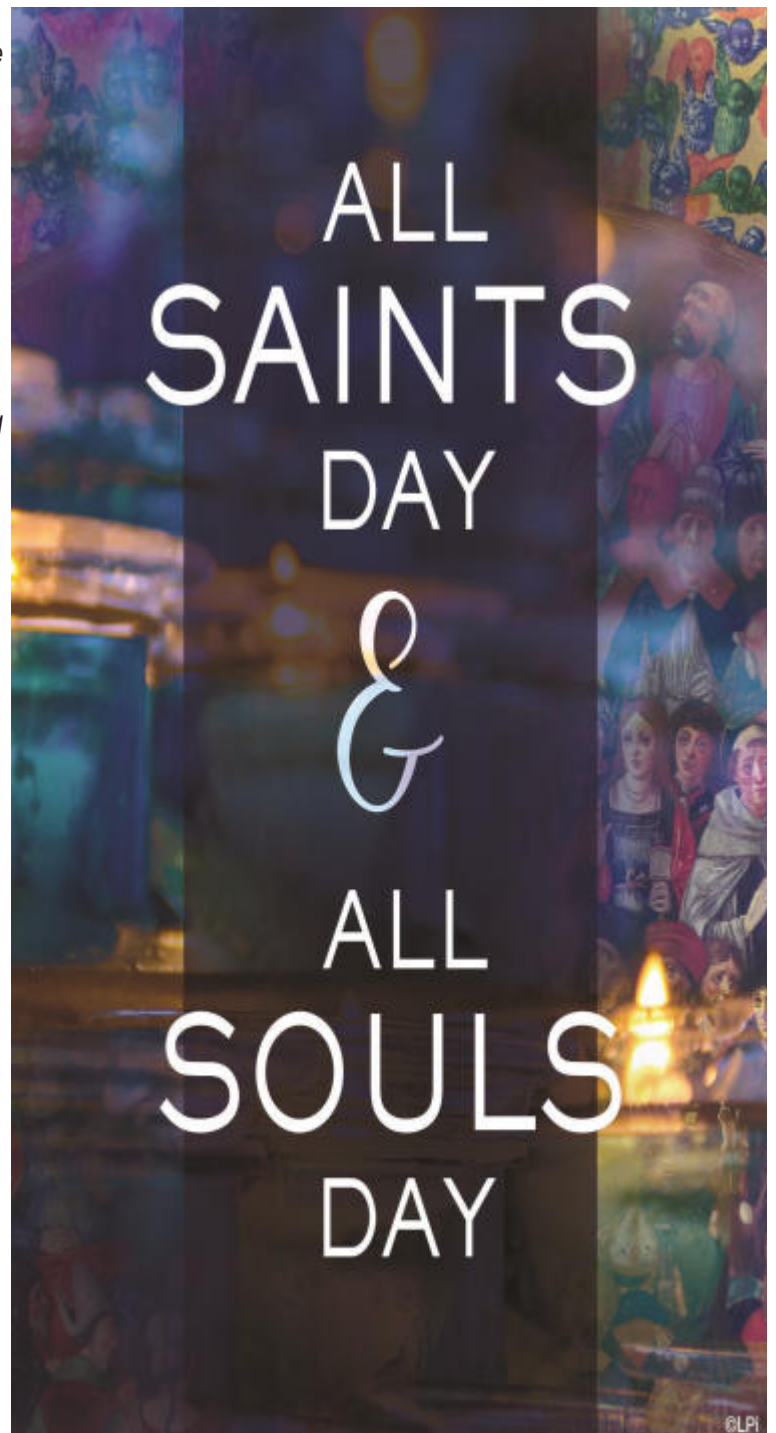

Pope Francis Quote: "Christian doctrine is not a closed system incapable of generating questions, doubts, interrogatives-but is alive, knows being unsettled, enlivened," said the pope. "It has a face that is not rigid, it has a body that moves and grows, it has a soft flesh: it is called Jesus Christ."

ALL SAINTS DAY: Why does Halloween take place before All Saints Day? Let's look at the meaning of the word. Hallow comes from the same root as holy, and a person who is hallowed is a saint-someone who has been sanctified or made holy. Thus in the Lord's Prayer we say "Hallowed be thy name." If we said that is using words derived from Latin, it would be something like, "Let your name be sanctified"- i.e., may people treat God's name as something holy and thus honor the holiness of God himself.

The part of Halloween is similarly old-fashioned. "E'en" is a contraction of the word even, an older way of saying "evening." Halloween is thus "All hallows e'en" or "the evening of All Saints Day," and it came to be celebrated as an early anticipation of the day that followed, the same way people celebrate Christmas Eve in anticipation of Christmas Day.

Why celebrate All Saints Day in the first place? This is the day we can celebrate all those everyday individuals whose faithfulness gave them a place in heaven. This is the day we recognize them for the way they cooperated with God's grace.

Reflection from Sister Gail

Often times our scripture is filled with symbolism that gives us a snapshot of what is important in our lives. Each line can call us to review areas of our lives that are counter to who we really are; spiritual souls, A voice was heard saying: "Hurt not the earth, nor the sea, nor the trees, till we sign the servants of our God in their foreheads."
