

### Reflection from Sister Gail

Our scripture readings are very clear about our focus being about sharing the truth about God in our lives. This special call for the family of God, means we do not share God's truth based upon politics, personal opinion, nor manipulation. God's truth is shared solely to help one another to know God, love God and to walk in his ways.

Once we understand the phrase, "we are the body of Christ," is not figurative, but actually literal; we can understand why it is crucial to never mislead a soul. While we can't see the spiritual cord that unites us all together; we are all one. You come to understand, if I hurt you, I hurt myself. It may not manifest itself in actual physical pain, but the pain of the spiritual loss is felt throughout the heavenly kingdom. Picture the sorrow felt after a human death on earth, as the mourning that takes place in heaven when the death of spiritual unity is witnessed.

Our readings remind us that Jesus destroyed hostility by his own person. Jesus bore the unbearable to give love a chance. The pain of the nails, the spear in the side, the lashes of the whip were to destroy the wound left from division in the body of Christ. Christ can show us how to turn dissension into inclusion, resistance into cooperation and polarization into unity. All he asks is turn to him and give him your thoughts that divide. If you are willing to be transformed, a heart of stone can become fleshy in the palm of the Savior. Ask Saul.


