Reflection from Sister Gail

Has Jesus died for you or is it just a story you retell? If Jesus died for you your life should be a living testimony of how this gift has changed and is continuing to change you. Being claimed by Jesus requires more than knowledge of the blessing.

This living witness calls us to put aside old ways on a moment by moment basis. Our readings last week reminded us what those old ways are: any bitterness, bad temper, anger, shouting, abuse or malice of every kind. Think of the situations in which you naturally react or act in the manners above. Jesus is asking us to allow him to enter those situations so that the outcome will change.

Engaging in the process of curbing one's tongue, speech, attitude and human nature is the work of one who believes Jesus sacrificed his life for him/her. That belief resides in the understanding that one's thanks is made up of letting go of those behaviors for which Jesus died to free our souls. <u>Eliminating the number of times you get angry</u>, <u>means putting on the mind of Christ, so that you respond</u> <u>out of God's perception of the event, not your own</u>.
