

Pastor's Column

Our **Marriage and Family Life Apostolate** is in full swing now. We are going to start offering a larger variety of courses for married couples/parents. These courses are open to anyone; you need not be a parishioner to register. Please share this information with your family and friends. We will have opportunities for spouses to strengthen their marriages and courses for parents to understand children and teens better. Below, I've included information about each course we are offering this fall. Registration is open for a number of different opportunities:

THE MARRIAGE COURSE. Over 90 parishioners have taken this course already! The sessions cover key interpersonal relationship skills for a happy and healthy marriage. Husbands and wives will converse with and share with one another about key aspects of married life. There is no group sharing in the course you and your spouse. The Marriage Course is seven sessions. All sessions will be in the Salesian House basement. Consider signing up for one of our fall options:

Option A: Tuesdays, 10am-11:45am: September 2 – October 14.

Option B: Saturdays, 10am-11:45am: September 6 – October 25.

Option C: Tuesdays, 6:30pm-8:15pm: September 23 – November 4. Childcare available.

Option D: Thursdays, 6:30pm-8:15pm: September 25 – November 6. Childcare available.

THE PARENTING CHILDREN COURSE. From the maker of The Marriage Course, this course is designed for parents of children under the age of eleven. It focuses on building a strong foundation, meeting children's needs, setting boundaries, building strong relationships, and having long-term goals. Each course is five sessions. All sessions will be in the Salesian House Basement.

Mondays, 6:30pm-8:30pm: Sept. 22, Oct. 6, 20, Nov. 5, 19. Childcare available.

PARENTING TEENAGERS. Digital curriculum designed for parents of children ages 11-18 who want to invest in the lives of their older children. The course meets every other week to give parents time to integrate practices into their family life. There are five sessions during EDGE program for middle schoolers so that both teens and parents can be here at the same time. All sessions are in the Salesian House Basement.

Wednesdays, 5:30pm-7:30pm: Sept. 10, 24, Oct. 8, 28, Nov. 11.

ADVENTURES IN MARRIAGE WEEKEND. This is a nationally recognized in-person facilitator-led program that gives couples the skills and time to discuss important topics in their relationship. It will be held in the Church Lower Level. Friday, October 17, 7:00pm-9:00pm, Saturday, October 18, 9:00am-1:00pm, and Sunday, October 19, 12:00-3:00pm. Free childcare available.

We are offering a special parenting course to accommodate our PSR parents during their class times, but all of the courses listed above are open to everyone. The QR codes to sign up are on the next page in the bulletin. Don't wait until the last minute, each course only holds a limited number of people.




