## Parish News & Notes

*From Fr. Frank*

When you and I get into our cars, the first thing we do is put on our seat belts and then we turn the key or press the starter button. Music?

Those devices provide each of us with countless choices. We can choose from every style of music - classical, jazz, easy listening, oldies, rock, hip-hop and more. We can listen to sports programming. We can tune into the latest news, weather, traffic reports, and stock market numbers. We can choose from among hundreds of different types of talk radio programs dealing with politics, contemporary issues, religion, health, finance, celebrity gossip, entertainment, family matters, culture, and the list could go on.

What we choose to listen to depends on our taste and mood. We select music and programming that we find enjoyable. That is especially true when it comes to talk programs. We generally choose programs where the opinions and views of the hosts and their guests are in line with our own. We tend to listen to people who reinforce and support what we believe.

In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 9:28-36), Peter, James, and John are told very specifically to whom they are to listen. In that passage, Jesus takes those disciples with him as he goes up a mountain to pray. In an intense moment of prayer Jesus is transfigured. His divine glory breaks through and Moses and Elijah appear and speak about what awaits Jesus in Jerusalem.

The three disciples then hear the voice of the Father. "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." With those words, the disciples are told that Jesus is the one they are to listen to and follow

That divine instruction given to Peter, James, and John is also given to us as this Gospel is proclaimed. "This is my chosen Son; listen to him."

To follow that command from God, we have to listen to the words and teachings of Jesus that are comforting and uplifting and that seem to endorse our view of life and our opinions.

But even more importantly we have to listen to the words and teachings of Jesus that make us feel uncomfortable, imperfect, shameful, and sinful.

We have to listen to the "whole program" of Jesus and not only to those portions that we like.

That program includes dying to what we want so we can live as God wants.

As we "drive" through our lives, God tells us very clearly that we are to be listening to Jesus. "This is my chosen Son; listen to him."

This season of Lent challenges each of us to consider how well we are listening.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made a minimum of 6 months in advance with the Pastor. Couples are required to attend a Pre-Cana session and a Natural Family Planning (NFP) class. FOCCUS is required and will be done with Fr. Frank for those doing marriage preparation with him.

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are held during Mass and are not scheduled during Advent and Lent. Call the parish office to schedule a baptism.

Parents seeking Baptism for their child must be a registered parishioner for at least six months prior to the Baptism. Non-parishioners would need a letter from their pastor giving permission to have the Baptism at St. Isidore Parish.

A one time attendance to a Baptism Prep. Class is required before baptism. Godparents (not members of St. Isidore Parish) are required to have a letter from their pastor stating they are a *Catholic in Good Standing*. A copy of the child's birth certificate, sponsor names and sponsor forms are to be submitted to the office before a baptism. This is so all records can be kept as accurate as possible.

Sponsors

Please contact the parish office if you have been asked to be a sponsor and are needing a letter stating that you are an active Catholic. You will need to have been a member of St. Isidore Parish for 6 months to receive this letter.

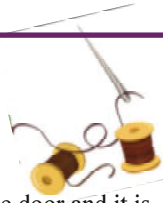

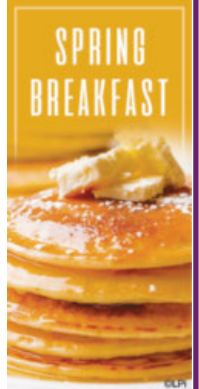

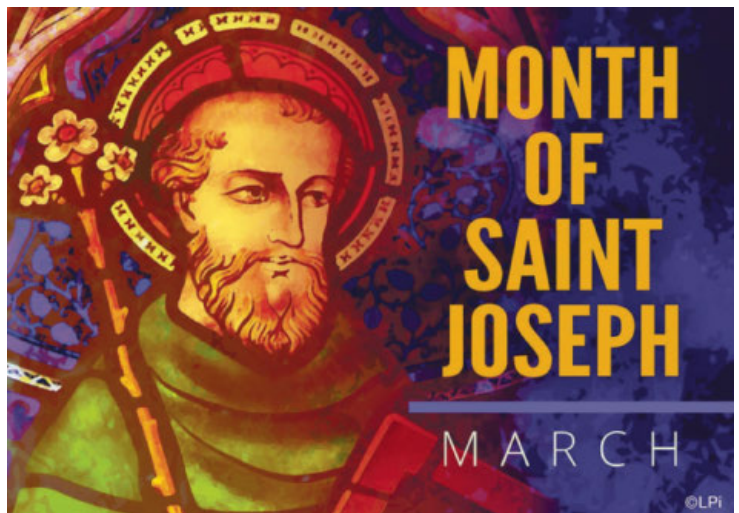


## Attention all ladies of the parish! CCW Meeting News!

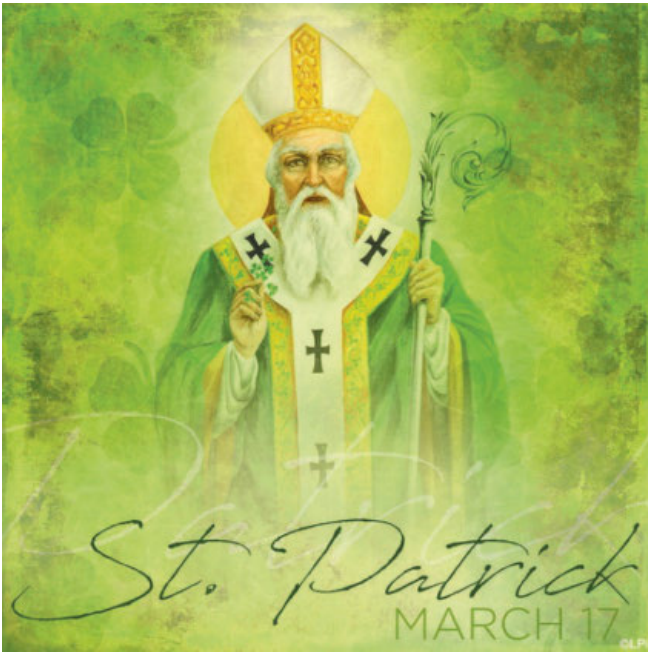

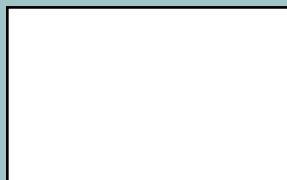

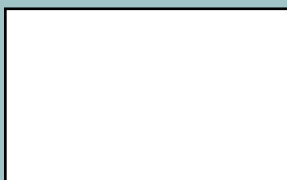
