From Fr. Frank

People use Facebook and other forms of social media because they want to be connected. They want to be "friends" with others and they want people to invite them to be "friends" with them. People want to share their lives with others and to reconnect with those with whom they have lost touch.

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The liturgy focuses attention on our belief that the One God we worship is Three Divine Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Three persons so "befriended" that they are one. We might say God is "THE Social Network."

God has revealed himself as the Father and Creator who brings all things into existence, as the Son and Redeemer who takes on our human condition and saves us from the darkness of sin and death, and as the Spirit and Sanctifier who opens our minds to the truth and inspires us to live so that we might be blessed with joy and peace.

How these Three Persons are One God is beyond our total understanding, but God is God and we are not.

Though our minds are incapable of grasping the God who made us, we have experienced being drawn into the social network of God's love in moments of prayer, in gatherings of the Church, in the reception of Holy Communion, and in experiences of beauty and love that take us beyond ourselves.

In this Sunday's Gospel ([Matthew 28: 16-20](#)), the Risen Lord commissions his disciples to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

In a sense, we sign ourselves into that "Divine Social Network" from which all life and goodness come, and from which God never "unfriends" us.



Tours of the Teutopolis Monastery Museum will be available on Sunday, June 04, 2023. The Museum, located behind St. Francis Church in Teutopolis, IL, is housed on the 2nd floor in the former Franciscan Novitiate building. An elevator is available for visitors who have difficulty with stairs. A collection of articles used by the early pioneers of the area and the Franciscan Friars can be viewed.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Arrangements must be made a minimum of 6 months in advance with the Pastor. Couples are required to attend a Pre-Cana session, a Natural Family Planning (NFP) class, and FOCCUS sessions with Fr. Frank for those doing marriage preparation with him. Please call the Office to begin preparations.

A parent seeking Baptism for their child must be a registered parishioner for at least six months prior to the Baptism. Non-parishioners would need a letter from their pastor giving permission to have the Baptism at St. Isidore Parish.

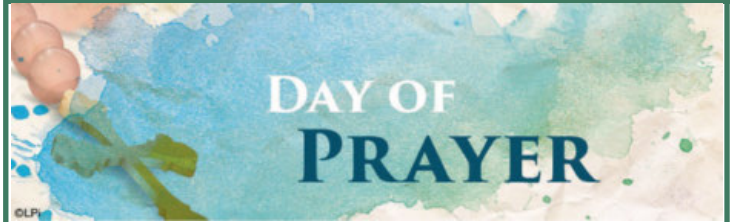

Visit the Cathedral in Springfield or Ss. Peter and Paul Church in Alton, receive an indulgence! – The diocesan-wide Year of the Eucharist going on now has a heavenly treasure of our Catholic faith attached to it. Bishop Thomas John Paprocki received permission from the Holy See, granting a plenary indulgence to those who make a pilgrimage to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield or Ss. Peter and Paul Church in Alton (the “Old Cathedral”) now through Dec. 8. One must also partake in the other usual conditions to receive this indulgence by going to Confession, receiving the Eucharist, and saying prayers for the intention of the Pope. These acts “may be carried out several days preceding or following the performance of the prescribed works. But it is more fitting that communion and the prayer for the pope’s intentions take place on the day the work is performed” (*Handbook of Indulgences, Norms for Indulgences, 23.3*). An indulgence a gift and grace that remits the temporal punishment due to a sin.

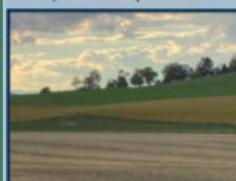
