

THE EUCHARIST IS REALLY JESUS' BODY AND BLOOD

Over the past several weeks we have been hearing passages from the sixth chapter of John's Gospel at Mass. This past Sunday we observed the August 15th Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. As a result, we missed hearing the Gospel for the 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time (John 6:51-58). It is important that we reflect deeply on this passage.

Jesus said to the crowds: 'I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.' The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' Jesus said to them, 'Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink.

Some of our non-Catholic Christian brothers and sisters have tried to suggest that Jesus is using "eating" in the sixth chapter of John's Gospel as a merely a metaphor for believing in Jesus. They would caution us against taking Jesus' words about eating his flesh and drinking his blood to literally. However, as Jesus' bread of life discourse unfolds the language actually intensifies. Earlier in chapter 6 St. John uses a more common verb for eating (the Greek verb *esthio* in Jn 6:49, 50, 51, 53). But here in verses 54, 56, 57 and 58, St. John switches to the verb *trogo*, a verb which literally means to "chew" or "gnaw." This shift to more graphic language does not suggest that Jesus is merely speaking metaphorically. When we connect this discourse in John's Gospel with the Last Supper narratives in Mark, Matthew, and Luke, we see that Jesus invites us to take him at his word when he says of the bread: "This is my body" and of the wine: "This is my blood of the covenant" (Mk 14:22-24). The Last Supper was Jesus' new Passover meal. He instituted the sacrament of the Eucharist and gave us the gift of the Holy Mass.

The early Christians believed that the bread and wine at Mass truly become the real Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Writing before the year 110 AD (less than 80 years after the death of Jesus) St. Ignatius of Antioch warned against heretics who "abstain from the Eucharist and from prayer because they do not confess that the Eucharist is the flesh of our Savior Jesus Christ, flesh that suffered for our sins and that the Father, in his goodness, raised up again" (Letter to the Smyrnaeans 6-7).

In the year 151 AD, St. Justin Martyr wrote the following in his defense of the Christian faith to the Roman emperor:



We call this food Eucharist, and no one else is permitted to partake of it, except one who believes our teaching to be true and who has been washed in the washing that is for the remission of sins and for regeneration [i.e., has received baptism] and is thereby living as Christ enjoined. For not as common bread nor common drink do we receive these; but since Jesus Christ our Savior was made incarnate by the word of God and hath both flesh and blood for our salvation, so too, as we have been taught, the food that has been made into the Eucharist by the eucharistic prayer set down by him, and by the change of which our blood and flesh is nurtured, is both the flesh and blood of that incarnated Jesus (First Apology, 66).

Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist was SHOCKING and SCANDALOUS!

In today's Gospel (John 6:60-69), we are told that many of Jesus' disciples said, "*This saying is hard; who can accept it?*"

Jesus asked them, "*Does this shock you?*" Jesus did not take the opportunity to soften his teaching or to counter that he was only speaking metaphorically. He simply allowed people to respond in freedom.

It is interesting that *as a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him.*

Our belief in the Real Presence of the Eucharist is one of the central mysteries of our faith. We need to remember that what we do at Holy Mass is serious. We receive the true Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ—NOT a mere symbol! As St. Justin Martyr stated, the only ones who should receive Holy Communion are those who are: baptized, and in full Communion with the Catholic Church through believing all that the Church teaches and through living a moral life that is in keeping with a follower of Jesus.





What if my child needs to “catch up” on his or her sacraments?
