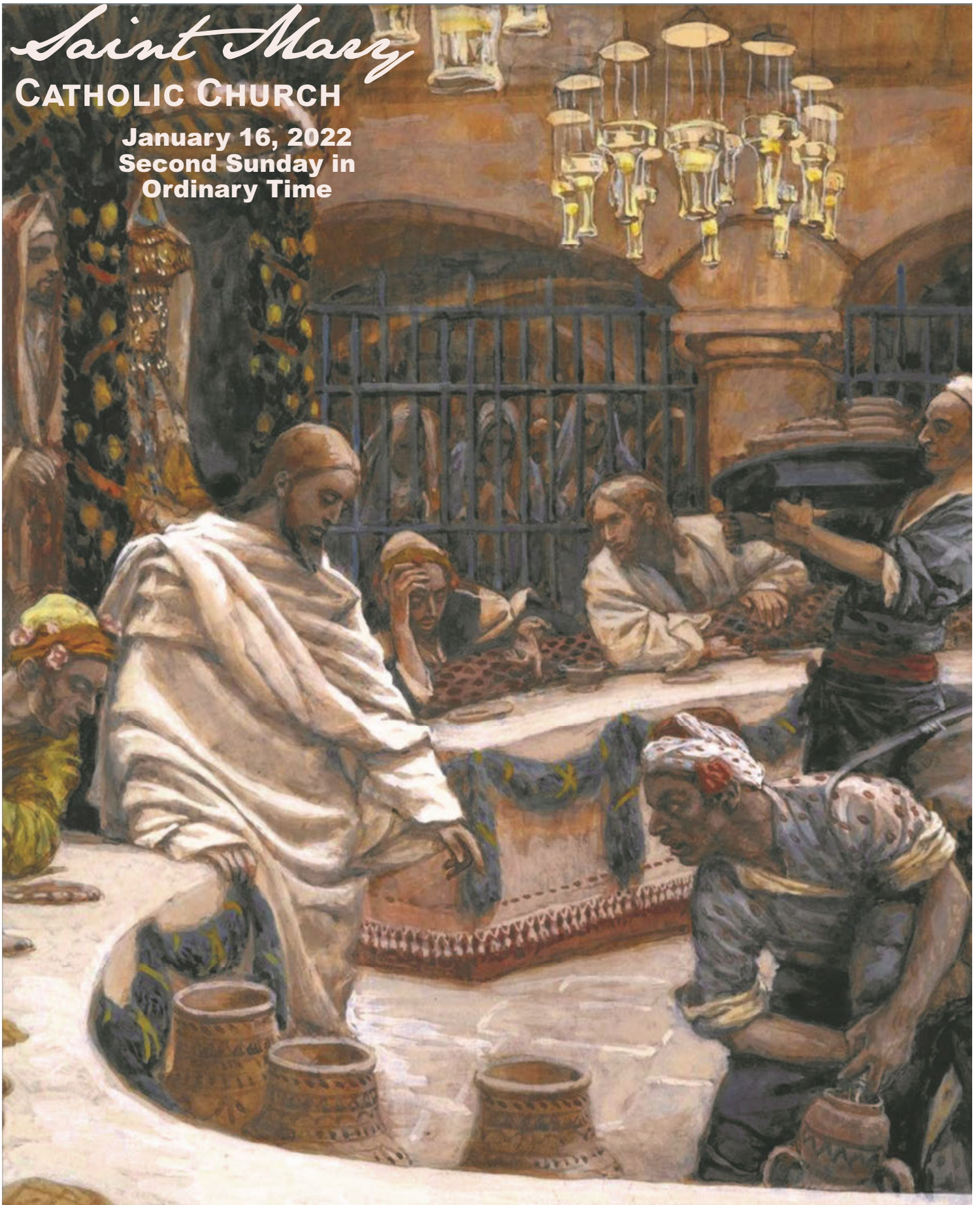

Calling all men: Exodus 90

Dear men of St. Mary,

Do you desire greater freedom? Do you want your Catholic Christian faith to be truly life-giving? Do you want to be the man that God is calling you to be—for the sake of your family, your community, and your self? I have personally known many men for whom this journey has been life-changing. Our world and our Church needs men to step up and truly live out our faith!

So try Exodus 90! **Exodus 90 is a unique 90-day experience centered on prayer, self-denial, and fraternity.** Over the course of 3 months you will develop habits that will help you to know God's will and freely accept it, all with the help of other men making the same journey.

Exodus 90 begins **January 17** and ends on Easter Sunday. Check out a description of the program below. If you are interested, contact St. Mary Exodus 90 coordinator John Kembrowski at kembrowski@yahoo.com. John will get you more information. Let him know your phone number and if this is your first time doing Exodus 90 or you are repeating the program (there are new options for those who are “veterans” of the program).

The Exodus 90 program:

Prayer

- Make a daily holy hour
- Read each day's provided scripture and reflection

Ascetical practices (self-denial):

- Take short, cold showers
- Practice regular, intense exercise
- Get a full night's sleep (at least seven hours is recommended).
- Abstain from alcohol
- Abstain from desserts and sweets
- Abstain from eating between meals
- Abstain from soda or sweet drinks (white milk, black coffee, and black tea are permissible)
- Abstain from television, movies, or televised sports
- Abstain from video games
- Abstain from non-essential material purchases
- Only listen to music that lifts the soul to God
- Only use the computer for work, school, or essential tasks (e.g., paying bills).
- Only use mobile devices for essential communications; cut out non-essential texting, app, and internet use.
- Take Wednesdays and Fridays as days of fasting. (Abstain from meat and only eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.)

- Check-in with your Anchor daily

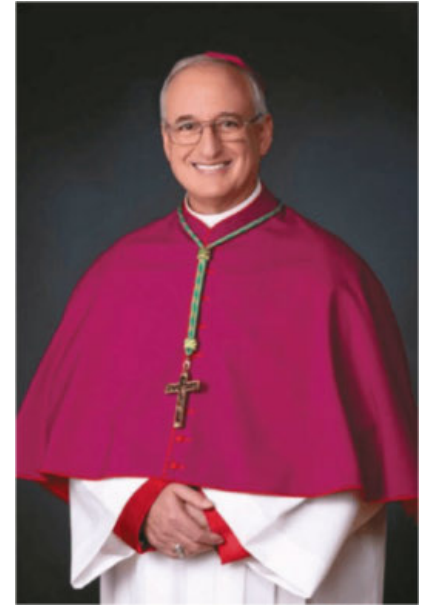

Guide us as we strive to make our parish communities places of welcome and assistance for mothers in need. Help us become instruments of God's love and compassion.

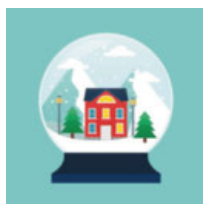

WHAT EVERY CATHOLIC SHOULD KNOW

If we want to love God and make him the center of our lives, we would do well to ponder the nature of God, at least in some small way. This book serves as a starting point for understanding what Christians mean when they say “God.” This book addresses three major concepts—the nature of God, the Trinity, and the Incarnation—so that we may strengthen our faith and our ability to communicate it to other people.

Some of us might protest that we are not smart enough to do theology and that less is more when it comes to contemplating the divine. But if God is perfect, wonderful, all goodness, love itself—as the Bible tells us in 1 John 4:8—it would be strange indeed if we did not want to give our whole selves to God, including our minds.

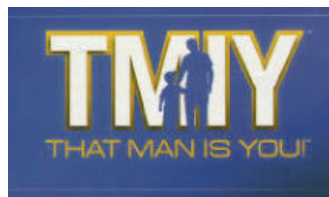


