

LET US PRAY FOR THE COMING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!

A novena involves praying for some special intention for nine consecutive days. Why do we pray for nine days? This nine days of repeated prayers teaches us to persevere in prayer, to wait for God with trust, and to prepare our hearts for the gift of God's grace. The most ancient novena in the Church is the Novena to the Holy Spirit. Forty days after Jesus rose from the dead, he ascended to the right hand of the Father (Acts 1:6-11). Then, for nine days the disciples waited for Jesus to send the Holy Spirit upon them, which he did at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-13). Most Dioceses in the U.S. (including Rockford) move the feast of the Ascension from Thursday to the following Sunday (the seventh Sunday in the Easter Season). Thus, Pentecost is a mere week away. Even if you did not start praying a novena to the Holy Spirit this past Friday, you can still start TODAY! The exact number of days is not as important as the desire to pray. Please join me in praying the following prayers every day until Pentecost.

- First, come up with a special intention for yourself.
 (Do you need the Gift of Fortitude to deal with an illness? Do you need the Gift of Counsel to help you make an important decision? Etc.)
- Second, please include this additional intention:
 "That the Holy Spirit would move the people of St.

 Mary parish to live out our mission: to help all
 people know, love, and follow Jesus Christ."

Then do the following prayers every day until Pentecost:

COME HOLY SPIRIT

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and kindle in them the fire of Your love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of thy Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolations. Through Christ our Lord, Amen.


ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Before the great multitude of heavenly witnesses, I offer

myself, soul and body to You, Eternal Spirit of God. I adore the brightness of Your purity, the unerring righteousness of Your justice, and the unconditional nature of Your love. You are the strength and light of my soul. In You I live and move and have my being. I desire never to grieve You by unfaithfulness, and I pray with all my heart for help in avoiding even the smallest sin against You. Mercifully guard my every thought and grant that I may always watch for Your light, listen to Your voice, and follow Your inspirations. I cling to You and give myself to You and ask You by Your compassion to watch over me in my weakness. I implore You, Adorable Spirit, helper of my infirmity, to keep me always in Your grace. Give me grace O Holy Spirit, Spirit of the Father and of the Son, to say to You always and everywhere, "Speak Lord for Your servant is listening." Amen.

PRAYER FOR THE SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

O Lord Jesus Christ, before ascending into heaven You promised to send us the Holy Spirit to finish Your work upon Earth. Grant the same Holy Spirit to me so that my soul may be sanctified and grow in the works of Your grace and Your love. Grant me the Spirit of Wisdom, that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal; the Spirit of **Understanding**, to enlighten my mind with the light of Your divine truth; the Spirit of **Counsel**, that I may always choose the surest way of pleasing God and gaining heaven; the Spirit of **Fortitude**, that I may bear my cross with You and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation; the Spirit of **Knowledge**, that I may know God and know myself and grow in holiness; the Spirit of **Piety**, that I may find the service of God sweet and enjoyable, and the Spirit of Fear of the Lord, that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread displeasing Him in any way. Help me, dear Lord, to be one of Your true disciples, and animate me in all things with Your Spirit. Amen. Conclude with one "Our Father" and One "Hail Mary" and Seven "Glory Be" Prayers.







THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS **DEVOTION**

Tuesday, June 7th, 6:00 PM Jesus promised, among many other blessings, that honoring His Holy Face through this devotion offers:

The **Conversion** of many sinners and mercy granted to their souls disfigured by sin, and,

Reparation for outrages against the Majesty of God - Communism,




The Holy Face devotion began when Jesus revealed Himself to Sister Mary of St. Peter, a French Carmelite, in 1845. In one of His many revelations to her, He said this of His Holy Face:

"Offer It unceasingly to My Father for the salvation of your country."

Our own image of the Holy Face, which will be on display, has been pressed to the traveling relic of the Holy Face of Jesus, a relic verified by the Vatican as having been touched to Veronica's Veil, the True Wood of the Cross, and the spear that pierced Christ's side.

This was a favorite devotion of St. Theresa, the Little Flower. She said that the suffering, wounded Face of her dear Jesus was the foundation of all her piety.





Answer: Far

better minds than mine have written entire books to answer this question. Instead of doing my own explanation, I thought that it would be interesting to see how the old Baltimore Catechism treats the subject of the Holy Spirit (the English word "ghost" simply means "spirit"). Here are a few question-answers concerning the Holy Spirit.

From Baltimore Catechism No. 2

.94 Q. Who is the Holy Ghost?

A. The Holy Ghost is the third Person of the Blessed Trinity.

.95 Q. From whom does the Holy Ghost proceed?

A. The Holy Ghost proceeds from the Father and the Son.

.96 Q. Is the Holy Ghost equal to the Father and the Son?

A. The Holy Ghost is equal to the Father and the Son, being the same Lord and God as They are.

.97 Q. On what day did the Holy Ghost come down upon the Apostles?

A. The Holy Ghost came down upon the Apostles ten days after the Ascension of our Lord; and the day on which He came down upon the Apostles is called Whitsunday, or Pentecost.

.100 Q. Why did Christ send the Holy Ghost?


A. Christ sent the Holy Ghost to sanctify His Church, to enlighten and strengthen the Apostles, and to enable them to preach the Gospel.

.101 Q. Will the Holy Ghost abide with the Church forever?

A. The Holy Ghost will abide with the Church forever, and guide it in the way of holiness and truth.
