The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#688) reminds us that it is in the Catholic Church that we come to know the Holy Spirit:

We know the Holy Spirit:

- Through the Holy Scriptures that He inspired (2 Tim 3:16)
- Through Sacred Tradition, as witnessed by the Church Fathers (2 Thes 2:15)
- In the Church's teaching office (Magisterium), which He assists and guides (Jn 14:26)
- When we worship and receive the sacraments, through which the Holy Spirit places us in communion with Jesus Christ (Jn 4:23-24; Jn 20:23; Acts 8:19)
- When we pray, as He intercedes for us (Rom 8:26)
- In the charisms and ministries by which the Church is built up (Eph 4:11-12; 1 Cor 12:27-31; Rom 12:6-8)
- In the witness of the saints, through whom He manifests His holiness and continues the work of salvation (Rom 7:6; Rom 8:1-13)

As Catholic Christians the Holy Spirit is all around us. He is the spiritual air that we breathe! However, I fear that we too frequently ignore the Holy Spirit and neglect to rely on Him.

Is there something that we can do to cultivate our relationship with the Holy Spirit?

We can start by simply INVOKING the Holy Spirit.

Whenever we begin to pray we can start by taking a deep breath and say several times: "Come Holy Spirit."

When we are feeling stressed out and anxious we can take a deep breath and pray: "Come, Holy

Spirit," asking for the peace and confidence that comes with faith in the Lord.

When we find ourselves facing a trial or temptation we can pray: "Come Holy Spirit, stir up within me your gift of Fortitude."



When we find ourselves at a crossroads or need to make a critical decision we can pray: "Come Holy Spirit, through your gift of Counsel guide me to make the right decision."


When we struggle to accept some aspect of Catholic teaching, we can pray: "Come Holy Spirit, enlighten my mind with your gift of Understanding; help me to see and accept the truth."

When we are struggling to serve other people we can pray: "Come Holy Spirit, give me the gift to be able to serve others with love."

The Holy Spirit is not an impersonal force. He is a person. The Holy Spirit desires to have an intimate friendship with us. When we invite Him into our hearts every day we are given the grace to do what we cannot do on our own strength. We are given the grace to walk in faith, and truly believe that we have been cleansed by the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ and reconciled with the Father. We are given the grace to love one another as Christ has loved us.




Dear Friends in Christ,



needed medical counseling, parenting education resources, and abortion counseling.



THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS DEVOTION

Tuesday, June 7th, 6:00 PM
Jesus promised, among many other
blessings, that honoring His Holy
Face through this devotion offers:
The Conversion of many sinners and
mercy granted to their souls
disfigured by sin, and,

Reparation for outrages against the Majesty of God – Communism,

Atheism, cursing, desecration of Sundays and Holy Days and other grave insults.

The Holy Face devotion began when Jesus revealed Himself to Sister Mary of St. Peter, a French Carmelite, in 1845. In one of His many revelations to her, He said this of His Holy Face:

"Offer It unceasingly to My Father for the salvation of your country."

Our own image of the Holy Face, which will be on display, has been pressed to the traveling relic of the Holy Face of Jesus, a relic verified by the Vatican as having been touched to Veronica's Veil, the True Wood of the Cross, and the spear that pierced Christ's side.

This was a favorite devotion of St. Theresa, the Little Flower. She said that the suffering, wounded Face of her dear Jesus was the foundation of all her piety.

Question: "in the Apostle's Creed" please explain "He descended into Hell". -Anonymous

Answer: This article in the Creed is covered in paragraphs 631-637 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The major source of confusion surrounding this article of the Apostle's Creed is the English word "hell." When we hear that Jesus "descended into hell" we wonder, "Why would Jesus go to hell?" It would be better to say that Jesus descended into the domain of the dead. In the time of Jesus, Jews believed that those who died went to a place called Sheol (in Hebrew) or Hades (in Greek). Sheol was a place of silence and gloom (Psalm 89:48; Prov 5:5, 7:27) outside of the vision and presence of God. Sheol was a place where there was neither worship of God nor memory of him (Psalm 6:5; 115:17; Isa 38:18). However, Sheol was not a place of eternal punishment because Jews believed that God would not abandon his people there (Psalm 16:10) and that God would bring redemption for the people there (Ps 49:16; 1 Sam 2:6). (Scott Hahn, Catholic Bible Dictionary). To say that Jesus "descended into hell" means that Jesus descended into the realm of the dead. In other words, he really, truly, and fully died. He preached the saving message of the Gospel to those in the realm of the dead, all those who lived and died before his coming. The just who were open to the truth were saved. Heaven was opened up to them. On the third day Jesus rose from the depths of death and Sheol.
