

AFTER ROE WE MUST DOUBLE-DOWN ON CHARITY

On June 24 the U.S. Supreme Court released their decision in the Dobbs vs. Jackson case. It is amazing that the Court finally overturned the terrible Roe vs. Wade (1973) and Casey vs. Planned Parenthood decisions (1992). In the Roe vs Wade decision the Supreme Court argued that the U.S. Constitution included an implicit individual "right to privacy" that also encompassed a right to have an abortion. Later Supreme Court justices (including the late Ruth Bader Ginsberg) questioned the legal reasoning behind Roe.

Contrary to what some people think, the ruling in the Dobbs case did not make abortion illegal in the U.S. It merely stated that there is no federal constitutional protection to abortion and that, therefore, the legality of abortion would have to be settled by state legislatures. At the state level people can debate, lobby, and vote.

What will change for us here in Illinois? Not a lot at the present. Illinois will remain one of the most aggressively pro-abortion states in the Union. Governor Pritzker has already said that Illinois will remain a "safe haven" for "women's reproductive rights." Imagine using that term "safe haven" in connection to abortion! Abortion is a deadly assault on what should be the safest place for the unborn their mother's womb. If anything, the leaders and legislators in Illinois will try to make it easier to attract women from other states to come to Illinois to have an abortion.

How should our local Church respond? On an individual level, we need to learn how to lovingly engage people in debate on the right to life for the unborn. In the months ahead I will be sharing some educational resources that can help with this.

We need to continue to lobby for life here in Illinois. I know that it seems like a steep hill to climb, but we just learned how 49 years of prayer and determination can achieve the seemingly impossible.




We also need to increase our outreach to women in need. We will continue to support local crisis pregnancy centers such as TLC Pregnancy Services in Elgin, Corbella Clinic in South Elgin, and Waterleaf Women's Center (right next to the Planned Parenthood abortuary in Aurora).

The Catholic Church now has the duty to continue to reach out in love to women and men in crisis pregnancy situations. We must love both the unborn child and the woman. Once again, we must be defined by our charity.

Because of the large number of Mass requests and the fact that we have more than 6,000 registered families here at St. Mary's, we will be scheduling multiple intentions at the 8:00 AM Saturday morning Masses and the 12:00 Noon Sunday Masses. All families will be limited to 4 Masses said here at the parish for 2023; one of those Masses can be on a Saturday evening or on a Sunday, or Holy Day of Obligation; the remaining three Masses will be scheduled on weekdays. All additional Mass requests will be sent to retired priests in the diocese, so the Masses will still be celebrated, but we will not know when or which priest is celebrating the Mass. 
SUMMERFEST MARKETPLACE

The \$100 Club has been established to help defray the cost of


Summerfest! We are not looking for the fest to be a fundraiser—we are simply looking to get closer to a break even

Question: Please explain "third orders." Are there any near our area and with which

religious orders are they affiliated? -Anonymous

Answer: Third Orders are a way that lay people can be affiliated with a religious order in order to receive formation in a particular form of spirituality and share in the charism of the order.

From the earliest days of monastic life, lay men and women would often attend Mass or the Divine Office at the nearby monastery. Though these lay men and women were not called to become monks or nuns, they did feel a call to participate in the spiritual life of the monastery in a way that was keeping with their vocation of marriage, family, and work in the world.

Here is another example from history. In the 13th century St. Francis started his "First Order" of men called the Order of Friars Minor (or, as they are also known, the "Franciscans"). They followed Jesus in a life of radical poverty and evangelization. With St. Clare St. Francis soon created a "second order" for consecrated nuns. Today these nuns are called "Poor Clares." Both of these orders are examples of consecrated life (men or women living the organizations you can call the Rockford Diocese or check vows of poverty, celibate chastity, and obedience in community). Finally, a "third order" of lay (not consecrated) or "secular" Franciscans were created. This

was for lay men and women who wanted to adapt the Franciscan spirituality and way of life to their daily lives in the world (prayer, living simply, etc).

Many religious orders today have third orders or secular affiliations: Franciscans, Dominicans, Carmelites, Opus Dei. They may be called different things ("tertiaries", Benedictines have "oblates") but it is basically the same thing. Usually a person must go through some time of formation before entering a third order. While they do not take the main vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience that consecrated men and women do, they do take some formal vows to the community and follow an adapted "rule of life." Joining a Third Order can be a great way to grow in a focused school of spirituality while also benefitting from a strong community.

Here are some Third Orders that are located in the Rockford Diocese:

- -Benedictine Oblates connected to Marmion Abbey in North Aurora
- -St. Joseph Lay Carmelite Community (out of St. Rita in Rockford)
- -Secular Discalced Carmelites
- -St. Francis Fraternity Secular Franciscan Order (contact is in Batavia).
- -Mother Cabrini Regional Fraternity of the Secular Franciscans (Elgin)
- -St. Peter Martyr Chapter of the Lay Dominicans (contact is in Rockton).
