BE JOYFUL DISCIPLES!

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus tell us, "By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples (John 15:8). A disciple is someone who follows Jesus. A disciple lives his or her entire life in imitation of Jesus the Master. Discipleship goes so much farther than simply identifying as a Catholic or going to Mass on Sunday (although, those things are certainly critical aspects of discipleship). Christian Discipleship encompasses the whole of one's life. If I am a disciple of Jesus then I am a disciple 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. I am a disciple whether I am at church, at home, at school, or in the workplace. I am a disciple in my prayer but also in my marriage, with my talents, with my money.

If we are to be disciples of Jesus we have to look at everything in our lives and ask the Lord, "Lord, how can I use this for your glory?" The money that we have is a blessing from God. Perhaps it is also the fruit of a lot of hard work on our part. That is true. However, it is God who gave us the life, the talents, and the strength to work and provide for our families. A true disciple of Jesus says, "Father, thank you for these blessings; I want to use them for your glory and the benefit of my brothers and sisters in need."

As Catholics we come together in parishes. St. Mary in Huntley is our parish family. Catholics are also part of a broader Church, a broader communion of disciples. The Diocese is the local church that is headed by the bishop. In the early 2nd century St. Ignatius of Antioch wrote, "Wherever the bishop shall appear, there let the multitude [of the people] also be; even as, wherever Jesus Christ is, there is the Catholic Church" (Epistle to the Smyrnaeans, Chapter 2). The bishop is the pastor who unites the Christians of a local church. We are members of the Diocese of Rockford, Illinois. The Catholics of the 11 counties of Northwestern Illinois are united under one shepherd. As disciples of Jesus we have a moral obligation to help support our shepherd.

This weekend all of the parishes of Rockford are announcing the 2024 Diocesan Appeal. The Bishop needs

financial support in order to help form clergy to serve the Diocese. This includes seminary formation for future priests, formation for future permanent deacons, and ongoing clergy formation. The Bishop needs financial support to proclaim the Gospel through youth ministry, university campus ministry, Bishop Lane Retreat Center, and the Hispanic Ministry office. Finally, the Bishop also needs financial support to help care for the poor and vulnerable. The Diocesan Appeal helps support our Catholic Charities Office, the St. Elizabeth Community Center, and the Life, Family, and Evangelization Office. Without the Diocese a parish cannot survive. Without the parishes a Diocese would be meaningless. We are in this together!



I am so grateful for the generosity of the people of St. Mary. Through the years you have given of your time, talent, and treasure in order to build and sustain an amazing community of faith that has had a great impact! As I conclude my fourth year as Pastor of St. Mary I have seen us exceed our Diocesan Appeal goal every year. Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! Our goal this year is \$252,958. I would love it if we could raise the percentage of participating households in this 2024 campaign. Last year only reached 15% of registered households making a contribution to the Diocesan Appeal. It would be amazing if we could get the number up to 20%. Even if a family could only give \$20 every gift has value. Even a small gift shows that you have some skin in the game.

Finally, I ask you to pray and discern what you can give. Whatever you give do so in a spirit of Joy. In next Sunday's Gospel we will hear Jesus tell us the following: "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete" (John 15:11). Let us be joyful disciples. Let us give back to God in thanksgiving for all of his blessings.

Question: Please explain some of the interesting aspects of the life of Padre Pio—his being a stigmatist and his closeness to the guardian angels. -Anonymous

Answer: “Padre Pio” was born into a family of agricultural laborers on May 25, 1887 in Pietrelcina in the Benevento region northeast of Naples, Italy. He was baptized with the name Francesco Forgione. From his earliest years God permitted little Francesco to see his guardian angel and also other people’s guardian angels. In fact, Francesc thought that everyone saw their guardian angel. Francesco entered the Capuchin Franciscan community in 1903 and took the name Pio (Pius, in Latin). People would often send their guardian angel to Padre Pio to ask for his prayers. Padre Pio used to suffer physical beatings from demons. On one occasion, Padre Pio recounted how his guardian angel suddenly appeared hovering close to him and singing hymns to the Divine Majesty in his angelic voice. For more stories on St. Pio and his guardian angel see Fr. Alessio Parente’s book *Send Me Your Guardian Angel*.



Pio was ordained a priest in 1910. Not long after his ordination Padre Pio began to experience pains in his hands and his feet. In September 1911 he told his spiritual director that he had suffered invisible stigmata for over a year. “Stigmata” refer to the wounds of Christ that a saint experiences on their own bodies. The stigmata tend to be in the hands, feet, and side of the body (some saints have also experienced wounds on the head as from the crown of thorns). In 1918 Pio’s stigmata in his hands and feet became visible and remained visible until the he celebrated his last Mass on the day before he died. Padre Pio wore gloves to cover the stigmata in his hands. Pio’s stigmata can be seen in numerous photographs although the mystical phenomena associated with him were investigated by the Church for years. Other saints have bore the stigmata. Some of these include: St. Francis of Assisi, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Rita of Cascia, and St. Gemma Galgani. The stigmata is a rare mystical gift given to a saint who is really close to Jesus. St. Pio of Pietrelcina, pray for us!

HAITI MINISTRY – AGROFORESTRY PROJECT UPDATE

We are very fortunate that, in the face of the social and political crisis currently underway in Haiti, our efforts to improve the lives of the farmers of Leger continues largely unabated. We are pleased to announce that we recently received a grant from the Raising Haiti Foundation that will add 20 goats to our livestock sharing program. When combined with St. Mary support, the farmers will be receiving a total of 40 more goats. A farmer who receives a goat agrees to pass along the first female offspring of the gifted goat to another farmer. The continuation of this process will eventually make this program self-sustaining.

As a reminder, The “Tree Currency” Program started by our partner, the Smallholder Farmers Alliance, is a resilient strategy that plants and maintains trees, combatting climate change and improving the soil, water sources, and biodiversity. Our participating farmers earn “tree currency”: crop seeds, agricultural hand tools, the livestock sharing program, and training; things they need to improve their crop yields and incomes. The Tree Currency Program not only nurtures the ecosystem and promotes sustainable agroforestry, it addresses poverty, food insecurity, community socioeconomic development, and, since women participate equally, it promotes gender equity.

We want to again thank all the St. Mary community for your continued support of this program.




