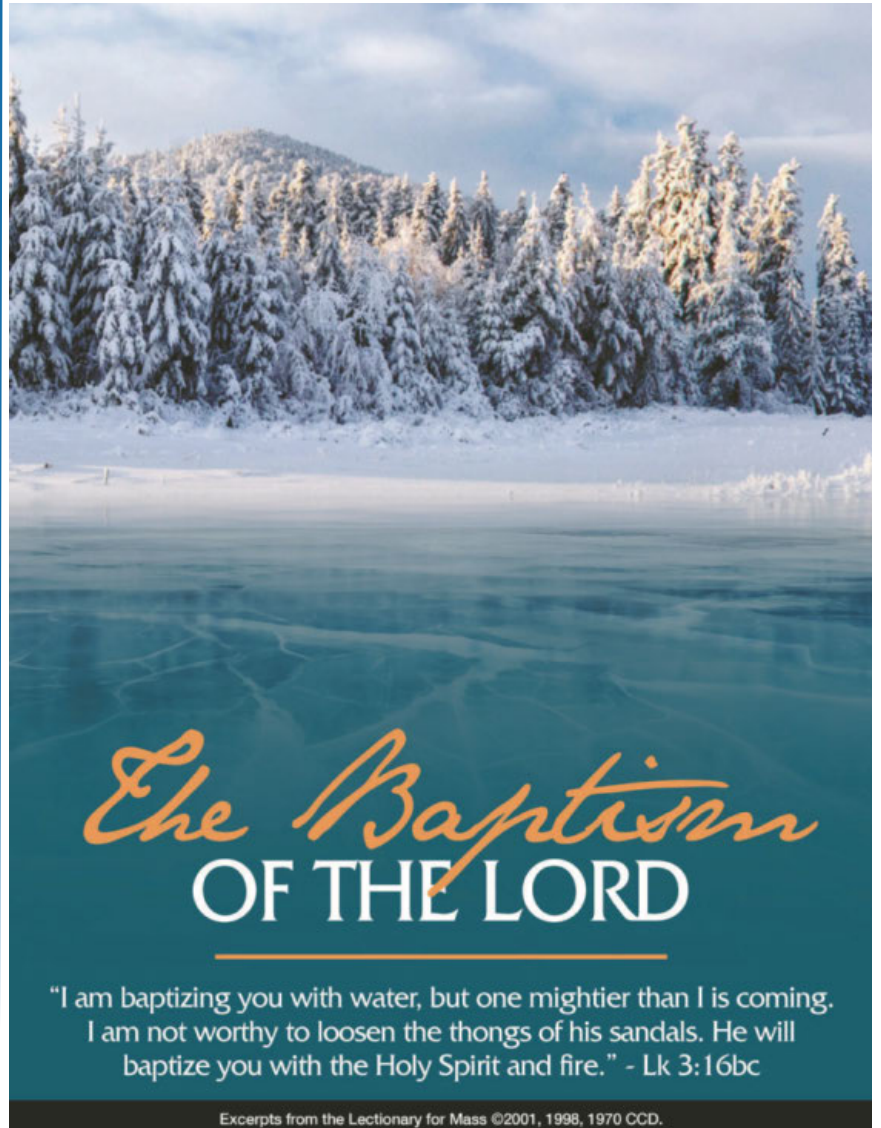

Intro to the Liturgy of the Day

No such dove was seen or voice was heard when we were baptized, yet the Holy Spirit did descend upon us in baptism and we were welcomed into this holy family, initiated into the body of Christ. Reflection on the Baptism of the Lord

There is a joke about a Pentecostal baptismal service. A drunk stumbles across a Pentecostal baptismal service on Sunday afternoon down by the river. He proceeds to walk down into the water and stand next to the preacher. The minister asks the drunk, "Mister, are you ready to find Jesus?" The drunk says, "Yes, I am."

The minister then immerses the man under the water and pulls him right back up. The preacher asked, "Have you found Jesus?" The drunk said, "No, I didn't!" The preacher then dunks him under for quite a bit longer, brings him up and says, "Now, brother, have you found Jesus?" The man replied, "No, I did not."

The preacher in disgust holds the man under for at least 30 seconds this time then brings him out of the water and says in a harsh tone, "My God, have you found Jesus yet?" The drunk wipes his eyes and says to the preacher... "Are you sure this is where he fell in?"

The story of Jesus' baptism, which we read in the gospel of Luke this weekend, is closely linked to the epiphany. However Jesus' baptism event is strange given the fact that Jesus is God and was conceived of the Holy Spirit. John the Baptist describe Jesus as the one who will be baptized with water, and the Holy Spirit and fire. Although before the baptism of Jesus, John did not speak so much about the Holy Spirit Jesus' baptism witnessed the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Him. God himself proclaims the identity of Jesus. Jesus' baptism thus, transforms the Christian baptism from a mere ritual act for the forgiveness of sin to actual participation in the divine life of Christ. To participate in all that is human, the Son of God also participated in the cleansing waters of baptism; but subsequently, offers the gift of a new life and adoption through faith. It is that gift of adoption through faith that we renew as we celebrate the baptism of Christ this weekend.

Note also that the celebration of the baptism of Christ brings the Christmastime to an end. Henceforth, we return to the ORDINARY TIME of the Church's year C.
