Substance Use Disorder does not discriminate and can affect anyone in any community. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported that more than 100,000 people lost their lives due to unintentional overdose and the total number of individuals who have overdosed and survived is even higher. Rather than depicting SUD as a moral failure or weakness, or lack of willpower, we are now aware of the greater context and can embrace the humanity of the person who struggles with SUD instead of blaming and shaming them. As we honor each person's journey, we promote healing and hope rather than disconnection and judgement. We extend grace and the opportunity for anyone struggling with substance use disorder to be accepted where they are without stigma and judgement.
Together we can make a difference!


No peanut products or caned goods without a pop top please. Those items will be collected the final two weeks of August and can be placed in the red wagon in the vestibule at that time.
