

From the Pastors Desk.....

Slogans are meant to be helpful, but they can quickly lose their influence if overused. The message, however important, begins to sound like a broken record, and we become tone-deaf. "We're In This Together" is one such slogan.

Ever since COVID-19 reared its ugly head upon our lives, the reminder cries out that "We're In This Together." We hear this battle cry from the Oval Office, the halls of Congress, governors, mayors, and every professional sports franchise! It's tiresome, and that's too bad because it is true. We are in this time of crisis together. Everyone has a responsibility to keep vigilant and embrace new disciplines to minimize this particular coronavirus' spread. Solidarity and compassionate understanding, as always, will serve us well during this time.

This weekend our parish announces our participation in our Archdiocese's major fundraising campaign, The Annual Catholic Appeal. This year's slogan for the Appeal is "**Come, Follow Me...and bring hope to the world**". Each year every Catholic and their parishes are invited to donate to this campaign that supports an amazing array of ministries and services throughout Cook and Lake Counties, our Archdiocese boundaries. Our united generosity helps the Good News of Jesus Christ stay alive and active in so many areas of despair, crisis, and genuine need. Together we ensure that efforts like Kolbe House Jail Ministry, Respect Life, and Catholic Relief Services succeed in their work. Each parish receives a fundraising goal; 7% of the

previous year's offertory income. For Fiscal Year 2019-2020, our offertory income was \$247,001, making our target for this year's Appeal \$17,290. If we go past this target goal, all donations are returned directly to that parish.

As always, I invite you to prayerfully discern how you can respond to this year's Annual Catholic Appeal. Printed material with more details about the Appeal is available in the tables at the back of the church. I encourage you to take a look at the pamphlets and to visit annualcatholicappeal.com for more detailed information. Next week we will list all the ways you can make your donation and pledge.
