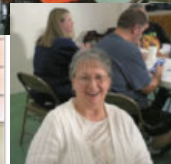

From the Deacon's Desk

We have now gathered ourselves and united with one another as the Church. Before we can approach the Eucharist, we recognize that we are not worthy. In order to approach the Eucharist, we must ask God for His mercy and forgiveness.

Our first action as we begin our prayer is to ask for that forgiveness. The *Penitential Rite* has several forms. It can be the *Confiteor*, which many old people like me remember from pre-Vatican II. It can be a series of acclamations of the Lord's greatness followed by "Lord, have mercy." Or it can be a combination of the two. If a deacon is present, this is usually led by the deacon. If you check the missalette, you will see some of the various options offered.

Once we have asked to be made worthy, we then offer our praise to God. The *Gloria* is, in my mind, the Christmas segment of the Mass. "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." *Luke 2:14*. This prayer, that is usually sung, begins with the words of the heavenly hosts on Christmas Eve. It is an ancient hymn and no alternatives may be used. It is sung at all Sunday celebrations and major feasts. The exception is during Advent and Lent when it is not used.

The hymn acknowledges God and His grace in sending His Son, hence it is sometimes called the "Hymn of the Incarnation." It praises both God the Father and Jesus for achieving our salvation.

Following the *Gloria*, we have the *Collect*. This is also known as the Opening Prayer. It concludes the Opening Rites and situates us to hear the Word of God. The *Collect* usually follows a set pattern. I tell people, if they are ever put on the spot to offer a spontaneous prayer, remember the following instruction I once received from a Benedictine monk. You, Who, Do, Through. You – We invoke God. Who – we make some acknowledgement of who God is. Do – We ask for a particular intention. Through – We ask that our plea be answered through, or in the name of, Christ or the Holy Spirit. Listen to this prayer at Mass and see if you recognize the pattern. At Masses where the *Gloria* is not used, the *Collect* immediately follows the *Penitential Rite*. The theme of the *Collect* will typically reflect the theme of the Mass for that day.

During this whole time, we have been standing. This unified posture is one that is both a sign of reverence and a sign of our "coming." We have gathered for this Eucharistic Feast and the posture also reflects our anticipation for what is about to happen.

As we will see in future discussions, our unified posture helps accentuate the "oneness" of the Church. So often what we do, what we say and what we see, all work together to reinforce the message that we are one in the Body of Christ.
