WORKING WITH THE SCRIPTURES

July 18, 2021 (*Mark 6:30-34*)

My family has always celebrated Christmas on Dec. 6, the Feast of St. Nicholas. Having emigrated from Holland as a child, my husband delighted in sharing this traditional Dutch feast with our children. When they were little, celebrating Christmas on a date other than December 25 was no problem. But as they grew older, when they came to visit, the working world and their part in it refused to stop for us, and it wasn't unusual for me to find my son on his computer at 6AM with customers in Europe and beyond. So when I read this week's Gospel I can almost hear Jesus talking, not just to His apostles but to my children (and to us?) as well. "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." Jesus knew the importance of taking time away from work.

Several years ago I decided that I wanted to take piano lessons. This required that I have my hand-me-down upright piano tuned, so I dutifully called a local piano tuner and set up an appointment. When the man arrived he quickly began his work, and while he worked we talked. He shared that he was Unitarian and I shared that I was Roman Catholic. He asked how long I had been playing and I admitted that I really didn't play often. After all, I was very busy. I had two kids in school. I was a Scout leader. I volunteered at church, worked full time, and had recently gone back to school myself. I was too busy to 'waste time' practicing.

And that's when he said it. "Mrs. Van Benthem, you of all people should not be bound by the Puritan work ethic." He might just as easily have told me to go off by myself to a deserted place and rest! He knew (as did Jesus) that the dirty dishes and textbooks (and "sheep without a shepherd") would still be there when I came back. Jesus knew His Apostles had been working very hard so He invited them to take some necessary time off. Today He invites us to do the same.




Calling all Bakers!!

On another note: John Laedtke, our former Pastoral Minister, was able to secure funding through the **Catholic Foundation Endowment Grant**. As Vincentians, we are now able to help our community members in dire need of basic bed mattresses and springs. We found, through our Home Visits, that some individuals were sleeping on floors with no support system. This grant will help secure the much needed help in this area along with bringing back a level of dignity felt by individuals and families through unexpected economic hardships.






