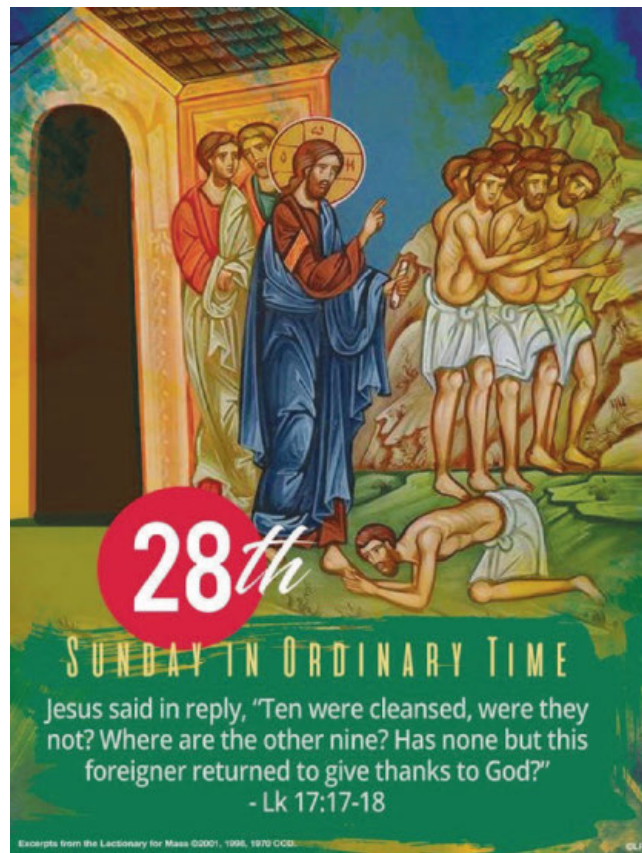

Dear Friends,

Early in the week I read, prayed over, and reflected on this weekend's Scripture readings, as I do each week. I remember a wise old priest who shared one of his mottos of life. He told me, "An attitude of gratitude wins." Throughout salvation history, Scripture and Tradition tell the faithful to give thanks. Today's readings highlight that.

Gratitude. I cannot stop thinking about the incredible response of this great parish to a need articulated by Father Bob Cook, the pastor of Mary Mother of God Parish (AKA Saint Thomas of Canterbury). My heart brims with gratitude.

To recap for you... As the asylum seekers continue to arrive in Chicago, they meet with multiple agencies at a central location. They call this place the MARC, multi-agency resource center. From there, they travel to shelters. We now have more than four shelters in our vicariate, mostly on Chicago's North Side.

As the weather begins to change, the seekers have been reaching out to the Catholic parishes in the neighborhoods. The Catholic Church symbolizes safety and gives them a feeling of home. They know that the Catholic Church is here to help anyone in need. They have been ringing the doorbells of Father Bob's three rectories. They need coats.

So, Father Bob called me, and I alerted you, the generous people of Saints JFX. He called Thursday morning. The school and the parish sent eblasts expressing the need. And by Sunday we collected – and the ACTION kids sorted and bagged over 500 coats! We delivered the coats to Saint Thomas on Monday. On Tuesday, the Feast Day of Saint Francis of Assisi, the founder, and patron of the order to which Father Bob belongs, he distributed the coats.

Father Bob called me Tuesday night. This is what he said in the message, *"I just want to tell you how great it went today. I have seen a lot of things as a Friar, but this was one of the most amazing experiences... Just the joy that it brought to these folks. They came streaming out of the shelter... I cannot begin to tell you the difference today made in their lives... so thanks again!"* I wish you could hear the enthusiastic gratitude that I heard in Father Bob's message. I share his fervent thanks.

Gratitude produces joy. Gratitude impels action. What we do each Sunday gives God Thanks. Even the term Eucharist comes from the Greek word that means giving thanks. Do we come each Sunday thankful for the gifts that God has given? Each person must fully and actively

participate in this expression of our joy and gratitude. Joyful, grateful Christians attract others. Pray. Sing. Thank. Celebrate.

Grateful Christians act. When we realize the many ways God has blessed us, when we acknowledge all that we have and are - admitting that everything comes from God, we ought do nothing but figure out a way to give back. Spending our time criticizing and complaining, stifles gratitude. Stifled gratitude paralyzes the Christian. Reflective gratitude generously gives.

Naaman offered his life in gratitude to God for the work done through the work of Elisha, the man of God. The cleansed leper (one of ten) enthusiastically thanked Jesus. I'm sure both lived their subsequent lives in service to God and neighbor. God has done great things for us. Let's thank God and devote our lives to God's service, generously giving back, and joyfully attracting others.
