





### Father Logsdon Logging In ...

This past week, Fr. Arbuckle and I attended a leadership meeting and the topic was hospitality. There are many directions this topic could go and many solutions for a lack of hospitality. One suggestion that came up, was asking people to greet one another prior to beginning Mass. When we discussed this at table, I brought up the idea that there is a tension between the use of our worship space. We come to Mass to worship God which can be considered the vertical aspect of our faith. The idea of greeting one another encompasses the horizontal aspect of our faith. In our faith, as Christians, the cross, contains both the vertical and the horizontal. If we are able to engage both the vertical and the horizontal aspects without becoming too focused on either one we integrate the entirety. How this can be done at our local parishes is the challenge that must be addressed so that we help one another live both the vertical and the horizontal. If people want to be greeters at Mass, please contact the parish office. If you have suggestions about how to improve hospitality at

our parishes, please, let me know.

As the school year begins, it is a wonderful time to consider our own education. Have we become stagnant in our growth, knowledge, and faith? It might be a good time to think about different ways to stimulate growth. It has been said that our faith is either growing or dying. Might I suggest attending Priest and a Pint, or sitting in a religious education class, perhaps reading a spiritual book, or even starting a book club. There are many ways to grow in the faith and I invite everyone to consider where you have come in your faith, and where you want to grow.

#### ST. STEPHEN OF HUNGARY—FEAST DAY AUGUST 16TH

Born a pagan in the 10th century Saint Stephen was baptized as a boy when his father converted to Christianity. Saint Stephen married Gisela, daughter of Duke Henry II of Bavaria who would become Saint Henry II. He succeeded his father as leader and began to transform the nation into a Christian kingdom.

Pope Sylvester II proclaimed him the first king of Hungary in 1001, sending him a crown and gold processional cross. The crown, made in the Byzantine style, has become a symbol of Hungarian nationhood.

King Stephen's reign was a relatively peaceful and prosperous time. He outlawed paganism, mandated church building, and tithing for support of the parish, and commanded all to marry except clergy and religious. He founded a Benedictine monastery, and Hungary became an important place along the route to the Holy Land for many pilgrims.

Unfortunately, Stephen's son and heir died in a hunting accident, causing much conflict over the succession when the saint died. Eventually the kingdom was won back for Christendom and father and son were canonized in 1083 by Pope St. Gregory VII. Saint Stephen I is now patron saint of Hungary.


