

DOING GOOD IS A SWEET THING!




Thrivent Action Team gift, the Wilson family was able to wheel in this cart FULL of GRAB-AND-GO snacks to the Ronald McDonald House.

Come, be part of the **ANNUAL MEETING** and then give your taste buds a treat at the **CHILI COOKOFF!** *Who will be the champion this year*?






COMMITMENT 2022


