FOOD FOR THOUGHT:

In modern Christianity, Lent has become about deprivation. Pre-Lent is when you dread what you will deprive yourself of. Lent is when you suffer deprivation. Easter is when you celebrate the end of deprivation. And the rest of the year, you regress to what you were before Lent, happy that the experience is over.

This is not how the Lenten journey is set up in the Orthodox Church, at least ideally. The period of the Triodion is supposed to be a period of planning the changes we hope to make during Great Lent. Great Lent is the time when we enact these changes. Pascha is the time we celebrate the changes we've made. And the rest of the year is a time to maintain our spiritual changes. The cycle then should repeat each year, so that as the year's pass, we see marked spiritual growth.



Parish Council President Notes March 2022

Dear St. Nicholas Family,

We are beginning our journey to Pascha as a Church family. I urge you to attend services, and worship with our fellow parishioners to experience the beauty of Lent as we prepare for Easter. By walking in the Lord's footsteps through our services together, we become unified and rejoice as community.

The Parish General Assembly is scheduled for Sunday, March 6th at St. Nicholas, immediately following Liturgy. Please make every effort to attend, we need your help and support to continue the great works of St. Nicholas. You are our church, without you there is no us.

I am humbled to inform you that an anonymous donor has pledged up to \$250,000 towards our debt reduction. We are beginning this debt reduction drive and pray that your generosity will help us raise at least \$250,000 that will be matched, and applied directly to our mortgage. If I may share, and those that have spoken with me, my ultimate goal is to have this mortgage debt paid in full, some will say I am obsessed, we are all working tirelessly towards this goal and I pray that we will be able to do this in the near future.

Please mark your calendars for our famous Lenten Fish Frys, held at the Family Life Center, Fridays, March 11, March 18, and March 25. As you may recall, we came in second place in the Fish Fry bracket last year – let's make it a winner this year! Please join us!

As you will notice the next time you are at church, the auditorium ceiling has been painted as well as the hallway leading to the kitchen and second floor conference room. Our next projects are to obtain bids from our roofing company, Bade Roofing, to repair the roof over the second floor Sunday School rooms and work with the tuck-pointing company to repair the west side of the church.

Father Doug's anniversary celebration of his 25 years as our beloved Proistamenos is scheduled for Friday, June 10, 2022 at the Family Life Center. A beautiful program is planned, as well as live entertainment by The Fabulous Motown Revue. Please save the date, as more details will be forth coming.

Preparation is in full swing for our annual Taste of the Greek Festival in July and the 105th annual Greek Festival over Labor Day weekend. We are grateful to our organizers and leaders that work so very hard to ensure the success of our festivals, this year we are planning and praying that we will be able to host our festivals in person. We are all so proud to have worked hard to make this the largest ethnic festival in the Midwest. The festival is vital to our budget, we hope that everyone can find an hour or two to help with the baking and prep - and of course, to volunteer at the events!

Dear St. Nicholas Parish Family,

In an effort to communicate the status of our loan for the St. Nicholas Family Life Center & renovations to St. Nicholas Church, below is a condensed timeline to recap the past 20 years.

1999: Purchased 10 acres in Town & Country for \$2,500,000

2003: Retired the land loan for a total of \$3,200,000

2010: First St. Nicholas Capital Campaign raised \$4,000,000 in pledges and construction began on the St. Nicholas Family Life Center as well as the renovations at St. Nicholas at Forest Park.

Total cost to complete construction of the St. Nicholas Family Life Center and major renovations to St. Nicholas Church onForest Park of \$8,500,000

2012: Signed loan documents for \$5,855,024

2015: Refinanced to a lower 3% interest municipal bond loan of \$5,273,184

2020: Extended our current municipal bond loan for 5 years at the same 3% interest rate and continuing the same amortization schedule.

2021: As of February 2022, our current loan amount is \$ 3,397,571.56 . Our monthly mortgage payment is \$25,500

We have made significant strides towards paying off our debt. Thank you for your continued love and dedication to our parish






