In the Small, Still Voice

The feast of the Holy Prophet Elijah falls in the middle of the summer (July 20), and maybe that's why it doesn't always get the attention it deserves. But his story can both challenge us and give us comfort, and we encourage all our parishioners to spend some time with it.

Elijah (Elias, in Greek) appears the books of 1 and 2 Kings as a prophet in the Kingdom of Israel, a strong critic of King Ahab and his pagan queen, Jezebel.

In 1 Kings 18, Elijah challenges 450 priests of the pagan god Ba'al to summon fire on an altar stacked with dry wood so they can make a sacrifice that will end the drought the nation has been suffering. After they fail, he has them soak the wood with water, prays to the Lord, and the Lord ignites the fire. Soon, the drought is over.

This account is inspiring, but the next episode of Elijah's story in 1 Kings 19 may have even more to offer us in terms of both challenge and comfort.

Thoroughly embarrassed by Elijah's putting her priests to shame, Jezebel sends her men to kill the prophet, and he flees into the wilderness. Eventually, he makes his way to a cave on Mount Horeb, where the Lord spoke to Moses. Exhausted, dispirited and feeling utterly alone, he prays for the Lord to take him. The Lord sends an angel to feed him and strengthen him, and when he is stronger, the angel calls him to look outside the cave.

Outside, Elijah witnesses a wind so strong that it tears up the mountainside, then an earthquake and finally a great fire. But the Lord is not in any of these. Finally, the Lord comes to Elijah in a "still small voice" (v. 13). The Lord tells Elijah that he has more work to do and that – no matter how isolated he has felt, he has never been alone in his faithfulness to the Lord.

"Yet I will leave seven thousand in Israel," the Lord tells him, "all the knees that have not bowed to Ba'al, and every mouth that has not kissed him" (v. 18).

This passage assures us that God's will will be done on earth as it is in heaven. We may not experience the signs of earthly power and success in our own lives – the might of the wind, the force of the earthquake, the destructive power of the fire – and, in fact, we may be struggling. But the Lord might be found instead in the stillness, the quietness and humility we find in our Lord Jesus Christ. In Him, we are never alone.

It can be a challenge to hold onto this faith when life is personally difficult for us. It's tempting to look for some other powers – some modern equivalents of the thunder god, Ba'al – but the only real power they have is to dominate, not to heal. So we hold onto our faith in the true God, who showed Himself most perfectly in the death and resurrection of Christ Jesus and whose is truly the Lord of all.

May God give us strength to hold onto this faith always.

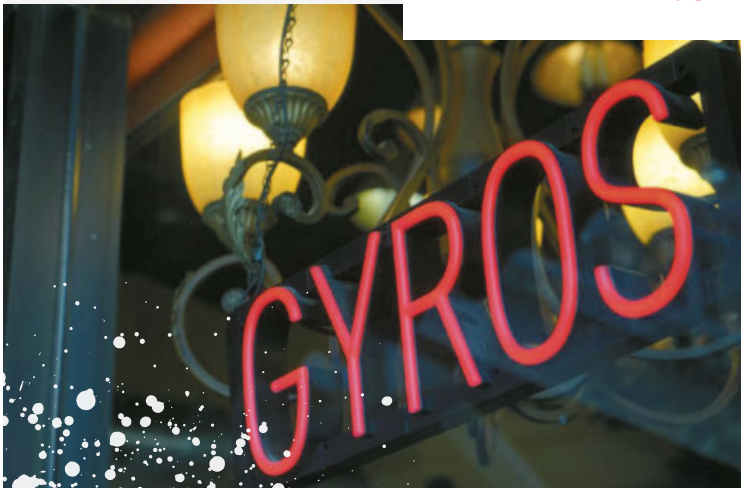

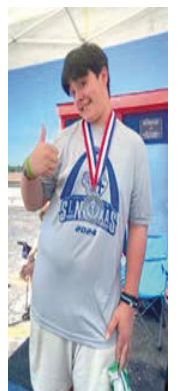

Dear St. Nicholas Parish Family,

In an effort to communicate the status of our loan for the St. Nicholas Family Life Center & renovations to St. Nicholas Church, below is a condensed timeline to recap the past 20 years.

1999: Purchased 10 acres in Town & Country for \$2,500,000

2003: Retired the land loan for a total of \$3,200,000

2010: First St. Nicholas Capital Campaign raised \$4,000,000 in pledges and construction began on the St. Nicholas Family Life Center as well as the renovations at St. Nicholas at Forest Park

Total cost to complete construction of the St. Nicholas Family Life Center and major renovations to St. Nicholas Church on Forest Park of \$8,500,000

2012: Signed loan documents for \$5,855,024

2015: Refinanced to a lower 3% interest municipal bond loan of \$5,273,184

2020: Extended our current municipal bond loan for 5 years at the same 3% interest rate and continuing the same amortization schedule

2024: As of June 5 our current loan amount is \$1,005,625 Our monthly mortgage payment is \$25,500

We have made significant strides towards paying off our debt. Thank you for your continued love and dedication to our Parish.

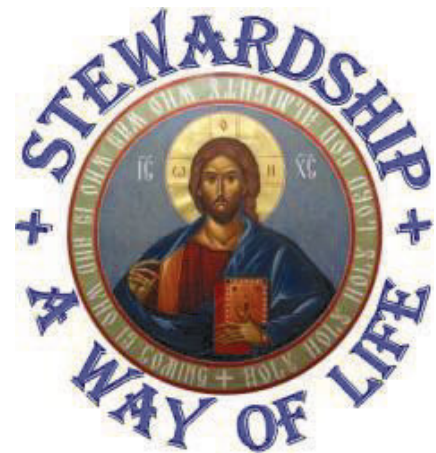

Ways to Give: Qualified Charitable Distributions

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals who are 70½ years old or older to donate up to \$100,000 total to one or more charities directly from a taxable IRA instead of taking their required minimum distributions.

- It's a smart way for individuals who don't/can't tax benefits from their charitable donations.
- QCDs are not included in taxable income.
- QCDs satisfy RMDs without increasing adjusted gross income, thus lowering or eliminating Social Security benefit taxation, Medicare premiums, alternative minimum tax, 3.8% investment surtax and medical expense deductions, or being bumped to a higher marginal tax bracket.
