Fourth Sunday of Advent - The Visitation

We have been hearing the prophets prophesying the coming of the Savior and the account of the Baptist crying out in the wilderness, "Prepare the way of the Lord." This Sunday we will hear the account of Mary visiting Elizabeth, her cousin, in a town of Judah, in the hill country. We refer to this event as the Visitation.

We presume that Mary goes to visit her cousin who is considerably older than she is in order to help her in the last 3 months of her pregnancy. We don't hear whether Mary has morning sickness or what her struggles may have been, having just found out she is with child, but we can presume that it carried with it the ordinary struggles of the early months of any pregnancy. She also just found out that she is to give birth to the Messiah, the privilege for which any Jewish mother would rejoice. Mary received the honor for which Jewish moms had waited for Millennia. Normally, someone of exalted position would expect others to come to them. She doesn't. She goes to visit her cousin.

Now, as a guy...and a celibate guy at that, I started to wonder: "What is it that a woman does when she visits her friend who is well-along in her pregnancy?" Does she help with the chores? Is she there for moral support? A combination? Something else? Please forgive my ignorance, but my speculation here can serve three purposes:

1) you will be able to tell how clueless I am and, hence, I will suffer public humiliation and perhaps grow in humility; 2) I actually got something right; 3) (most likely) I am somewhere in between right and wrong. I do not know anything about being pregnant (I hope this is obvious), but I do know something about walking with a convert or a young person answering the call to religious life. I look forward to your emails. Thank you in advance for helping me grow in humility.

Mary walks in the door and Elizabeth rightly predicts that Mary is the Mother of the Messiah...the one long awaited by millions of Jewish people for generations. Does Elizabeth then ask her to do the laundry? Well...I am guessing Mary did help out with the chores (cooking, cleaning, keeping Zechariah out of her hair, etc.), because she is Mary and was there for 3 months, but I speculate that there are two other things going on here for which the chores are only a pretense and perhaps the real reason for the visit: 1) Elizabeth is excited about having her first child and we, human beings, share our joys; and, 2) Elizabeth has some fear about the unknowns of having her first child and Mary will walk with her through those fears, uncertainties, anxieties, etc. Joy, excitement, fear and uncertainty all wrapped into one. Let's face it: babies are pretty fragile and needy little humans and it is great to have someone there with you to talk things through, process experiences and questions, etc. My guess is that Mary and Elizabeth took great comfort in going through all this together and, as I have already confessed, it is an experience that, no matter how sensitive and thoughtful we might be, a guy does not fully understand. This becomes even more the case when your child is the "voice crying out in the wilderness" or the Son of God.

So, our lesson? Advent is a time for us to walk together toward the celebration of the Birth of the Messiah. We live in a time of great excitement as well as fear and uncertainty. Let's pray for each other and be open to the visit of the Lord, whatever He may bring.

May Almighty God bless you and keep you. Prayers.




