#### **Covid Update**

DuPage County has now exceeded the 8.1% positivity rate. We have not received any instruction to change our protocols from the Diocese or the State in this regard. We were glad to see almost all wearing masks at Christmas masses and encourage others to do the same. Fortunately, hospitalizations due to Covid in DuPage County have plummeted to a seven-day rolling average of 4 which is 1/3 the number from just a week ago. 76.73% of all residents aged 18 and up in DuPage County have been vaccinated as of December  $26^{th}$ . On Saturday, January 8, 2022, St. Petronille Choose Life! Ministry is sponsoring our fifth bus trip to the March for Life Chicago. It is an inspiring event to be a part of because of the numbers of enthusiastic pro-life people who come from all over the Mid-west, making it the largest march in the US outside of the original annual March in Washington DC, and because of the youthfulness abounding all around in the crowd. The number of very animated teens and young adults attending the march is a very real sign of hope that the culture of death in our country may be on the wane.

Another sign of hope is happening through our country's legislative community. While Catholics have faithfully acknowledged the objective reality and undeniable humanity of the child in the womb, the humanity of a child is increasingly being recognized, through advances in science, as being present from the moment of conception and current debate regarding of the governments interest in the protection of the life of a child is hovering around the fifteen-week mark, seven to nine weeks earlier than the current viability marker recognized by twenty states. The chipping away of "law" at the state level has further forced the discussion out into the open whereby individuals must decide where they stand on recognizing the intrinsic human dignity of the child in the fetal stage of development. The imagined middle ground (sometimes falsely clung to by Catholics) is disappearing.

Marching never mattered more for the pro-life movement. In the past twenty months we have witnessed many people in our country marching and protesting, asking for an increase in social justice for those who have suffered societal harm, physical and social abuse, or the denial of rights. On January 8th the March for Life Chicago will march on the Magnificent Mile to give a voice to the 63 million children lost to our nation through the diabolically made-up "right to abortion" that launched the culture of death which has peddled contempt for vulnerable human life to generations of young people for the past 49 years. I will be marching to reinstate the protections formally afforded to unborn children prior to Roe and to increase protections for girls, recently denied in Illinois, against predatory men and human traffickers who hide their criminal activity with the assistance of the abortion industry.



May you and your family experience God's peace and joy this holiday season. We wish you a very happy and healthy year in 2022!


