I believe that this process is extremely important, and I encourage each and every parish family to participate. Your input is valuable as we plan for the future of St. Petronille Parish.



#### Fr. Jesus Update

Fr. Jesus has had very mild symptoms of Covid but continues to quarantine. We are hoping that he will get the all-clear within a day or two. Fr. John and I continue to show no signs of infection.



#### **Covid Update**

Although the DuPage County positivity rate (7-day rolling average) continues to be high, it has dropped significantly and now stands at 15.9%. #### Christmas Creche'

Happily, some have noticed that the Christmas Creche' (Nativity Scene) is still present in our church. Although this is explained every year, here it goes again. The liturgical season of Christmas is over and most of the Christmas decorations have been taken down not to be seen again until December 24, 2022; however, the Nativity continues to make its presence known. Some have speculated that it is because the Orthodox celebrate Christmas on a different date. Since this is not exactly accurate, this is not the reason. Some think that the maintenance man hurt his back taking down the big Christmas trees and so he couldn't take down the creche'. Others believe that Fr. Milota is simply out of his mind. Whereas it may be true that I am "out of my mind, it is for the Lord."

The reason: although some may be unfamiliar with this tradition, it is a Catholic thing to do. Although the Christmas season ended on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, Catholics for centuries have recognized a connection between the Solemnity of the Nativity of our Lord, Christmas, and the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. In fact, most of the Popes of the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century would keep their Christmas Creche' up until February 2<sup>nd</sup>. Dom Prosper Gueranger wrote, concerning the connection between Christmas and the Presentation (Purification):

...for it (the Gospel) tells us that the Blessed Virgin Mary, after spending 40 days in the contemplation of the divine fruit of her glorious maternity, went to the temple, there to fulfill, in most perfect humility, the ceremonies which the law demanded of the daughters of Israel when they became mothers. The feast of Mary's purification is, therefore, part of that of Jesus' birth; and the custom of keeping this holy and glorious period of forty days as one continued Festival has every appearance of being a very ancient one, at least in the Roman Church.

Although we do not include a Christmastide of 40 days in our liturgy, the tradition of keeping the Christmas creche' up until February 2<sup>nd</sup> is common in many parts of the world and in some parts of the United States. The Presentation of the Lord is also called "candlemas" because it is on this day that all of the church candles are blessed for the coming year. The scripture passage we read on this day recounts the words of Simeon as he beheld the Christ Child: "...for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." The Christ Child, seen in the manger and presented in the Temple, is a light to all the nations, Gentile and Jew alike...it is, as if, in this moment, the Church reminds us that this small baby held in his mother's arms is the light of the world and this light shines out to all so that we might seek this light and be reborn in His image and likeness.

**ESSE – Ecumenical Support Services for the Elderly** is a not-for-profit organization that provides adult day care options that promote the physical, emotional, and spiritual




