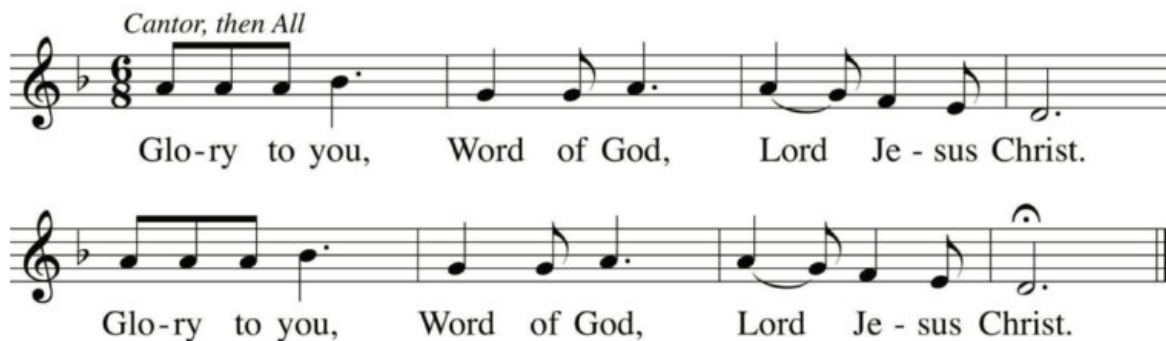

- **Saturday, April 9:** (5 volunteers needed to build)

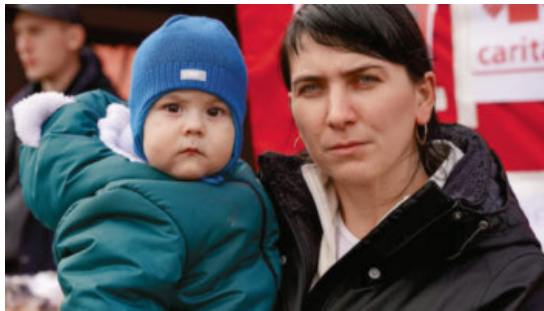
Other signups dates for Wednesdays and Saturday through April, May and June will be forthcoming.

URGENT NEED IN UKRAINE

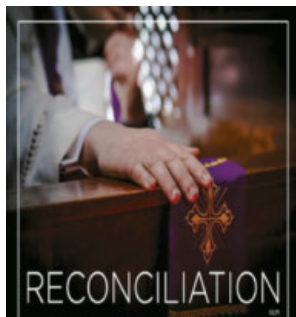
