#### **HIGHLIGHTS FROM APRIL 7 MEETING**

Pastoral Council reviewed **LISTENS AND RESPONDS** comments from March 26/27. Subcommittee Chair will respond to those who submitted questions. Request for summer Mass time at 5pm on Saturday. This has been asked before. Saint Bernadette will keep it at 4pm. Suggestion for new ministry about pastoral care to people following medical illness. Issue has been referred to Sharon Schuhmann to explore how this could be developed. Other suggestions on how to better engage youth in the parish during Mass were referred to David Zorn.

There will be **4 OPENINGS ON PASTORAL COUNCIL** beginning July 2022. So far we have received 3 nominations. The deadline is April 24. Nominees will be invited to attend a discernment meeting on Wednesday, May 11 at 6:30pm or Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. Fr. Pepper will select new council names on Friday, May 27. Announce to parish May 28/29. Invited to first Pastoral Council Meeting on June 2.

(WINGS) WORKING IN GOD'S SERVICE GROUP, a social service ministry at Saint Bernadette, has requested approval to adopt 2 miles of Hwy 1694 in front of church. Commitment is for 2 years – minimum of 4x a year. Pastoral Council to refer request to Business Manager for advice and then discuss again at May meeting.

Fr. Pepper raised the idea to resume passing the **COLLECTION BASKET**. Loose collections are down considerably since COVID. Adding something to the basket and bringing forth the basket is part of the act of worship – visible symbol of self-offering. Fr. Pepper will continue to explore this issue with staff and discuss again at May meeting.

Fr. Jeff has been appointed by the Archbishop to Saint Bernadette for a  $2^{nd}$  6-year term beginning in June 2022.






