

#### STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATE

Although it has been a little while since we have provided an update on our Strategic Plan, the hard work of so many parishioners has not been forgotten. Staff continues to work on finding ways to implement the strategies identified in the plan as we continue to move out of the pandemic.

The strategies identified during the planning process include:

- 1. Live as Intentional Disciples in the world through a comprehensive approach to what it means to be an Intentional Disciple
- 2. Provide outreach to target audiences for their Spiritual and Physical needs./To increase our focus on building a more engaged and connected community to support and grow our parish and increase the sense of belonging for everyone.
- 3. Develop a culture of service and stewardship inside and outside our campus through engaging opportunities, with a missionary spirit, to tell our story and grow disciples.
- 4. Embrace the school as a pastoral instrument of the parish a place of evangelization of the young.
- 5. Create fundraising at St. Bernadette that is sponsored by, attended by, and benefits the entire parish.
- 6. Build a brand identity that comfortably houses the parish and all its ministries.
- 7. Embrace our big church reality with the staffing and infrastructure that match.
- 8. Increase parishioner giving via education and relevance.
- 9. Increase student population.
- 10. Build understanding of and commitment to our shared financial obligations (debt).
- 11. Simplify access to and sharing of all information to the entire St. Bernadette community

A few examples of progress in these areas can be seen in

- 2021 Parish Census and increased online giving through WeShare
- The addition of 2 new staff members in 2021 Neighbor Care Outreach Coordinator, Ellen Creely and Assistant Director of Worship, Kelley Magnuson. Ellen is working to support and expand our outreach in the community, and Kelley is enhancing worship with the formation of a children's choir.
- Coordinated review and expansion of stewardship program within Saint Mary Academy with direction from Saint Bernadette Staff - Ellen Creely and Elizabeth Auffrey.
- Mission Advancement Advocate, who writes and distributes the parish bulletin, taking on responsibility for writing and distributing the SMA Newsletter allows for a greater crossover of news between school and parish.

Stay tuned for more updates as 2022 progresses! We look forward to discussing this plan with the new SMA Principal, Mr. Timmerberg and further work on goals when Fr. Jeff returns this fall.


The **ROSARY AND THE CHAPLET OF MERCY** is prayed in the Chapel weekdays following Mass and 8:00am before Sunday Masses.




