Baptism of Our Lord

The conclusion of the Christmas season brings the celebration of Our Lord's Baptism by John the Baptist. 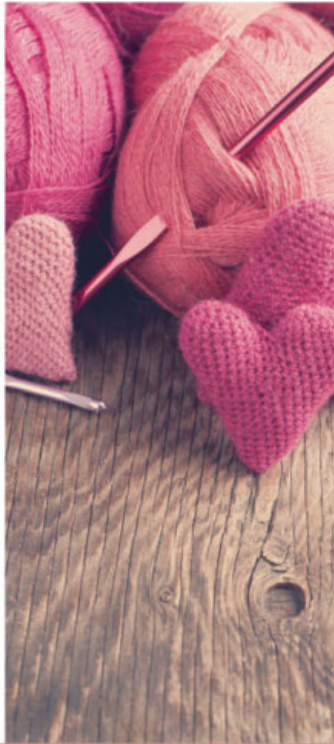
Prayer Shawl Ministry AT ASCENSION

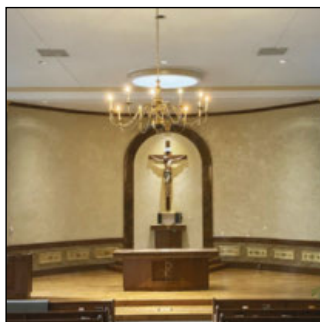
