



What is the movie about? It is a true story about Louis "Louie" Zamperini who, as a boy, was always in trouble, but with the help of his older brother, he turned his life around and channeled his energy into running, later qualifying for the 1936 Olympics. When World War II broke out, Louie enlisted in the military. After his plane crashed in the Pacific, he survived an incredible 47 days adrift in a raft, until his capture by the Japanese navy. Sent to a POW camp, Louie became the favorite target of a particularly cruel prison commander. And yet, his spirit is "unbroken."




