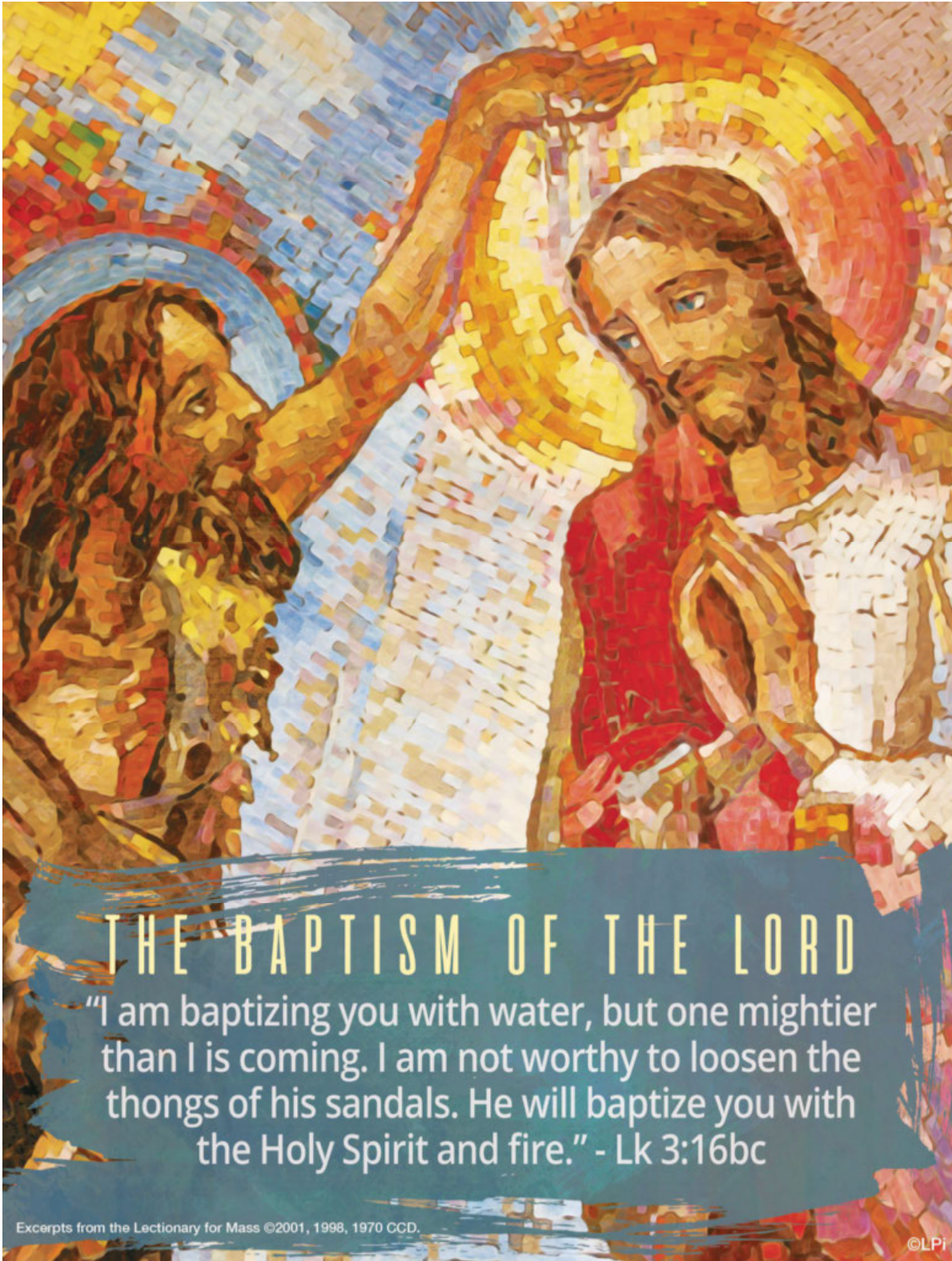

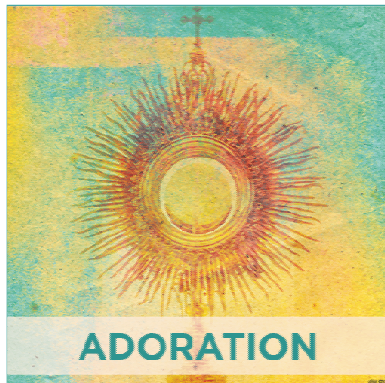

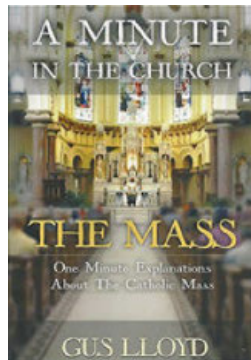

Sent to a POW camp, Louie became the favorite target of a particularly cruel prison commander. And yet, his spirit is "unbroken."

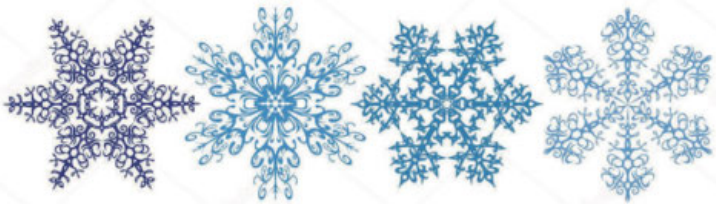

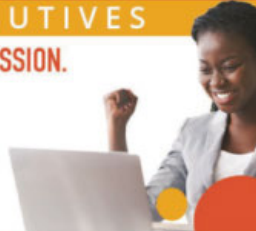
