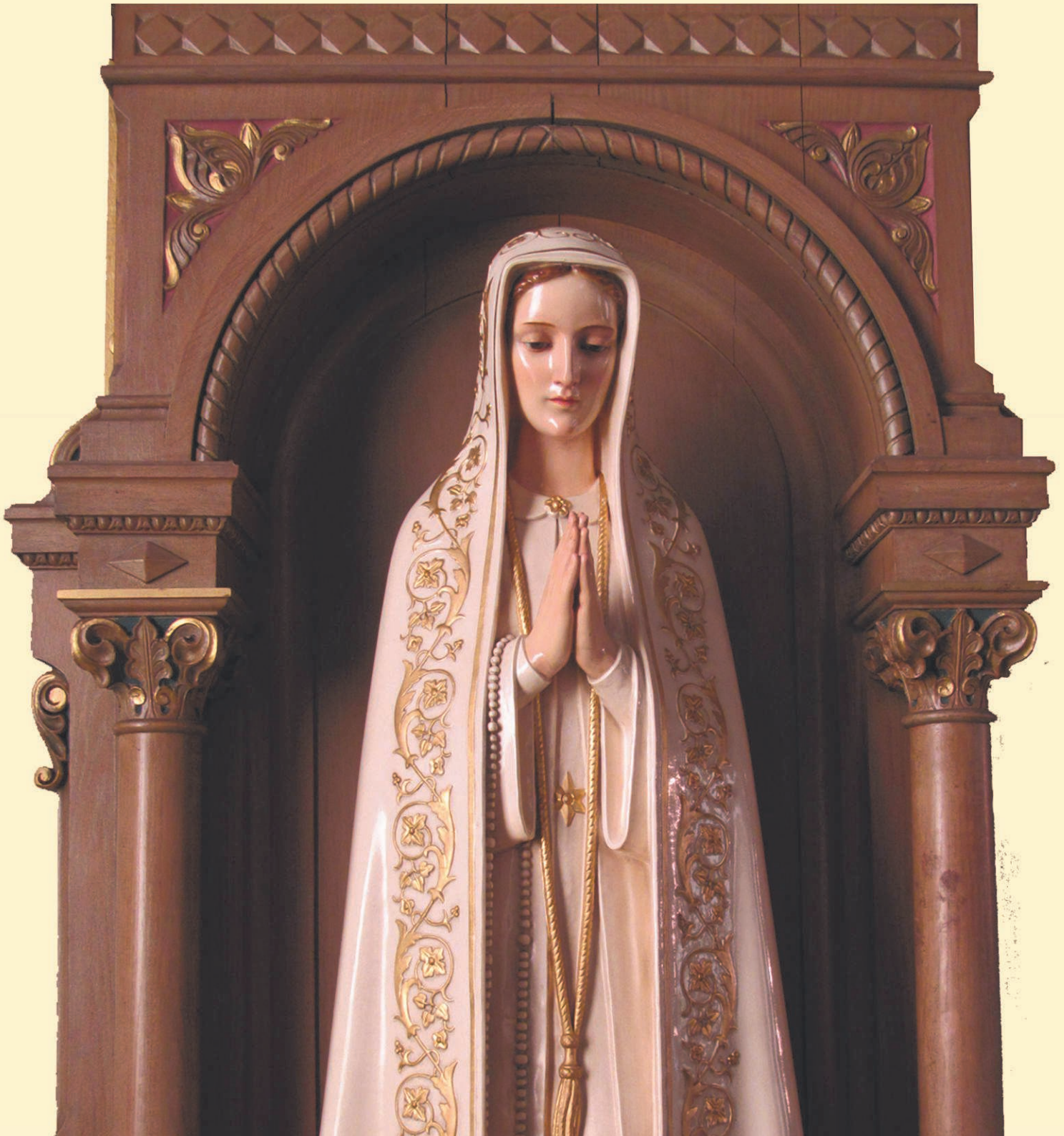

With much gratitude to God and to you, we present a summary of the 2018-2019 financial activity of St. Katharine Drexel Parish. We have been blessed to finish our fiscal year on a very positive note. Parishioners and visitors alike gave generously to support our basic parish needs. Our fundraisers were quite successful due to the efforts of so many volunteers and participants.

Looking forward, however, we still have many challenges that will require additional funds.

We have been blessed with the services of a Music Director. Since March 1, 2019 her salary and benefits have been added to our budget.

We have many wonderful facilities in which to minister and enjoy parish activities. However, these facilities have aging infrastructures that require attention. St. Patrick's Church will soon need a new roof. Additionally most of our buildings need some tuck pointing and other external work to ensure their useful longevity and to improve utility efficiency. Since July 1<sup>st</sup> we have been able to rebuild the exterior fire escape stairs for the Parish Center, as well as both of the rear external stairs at St. Pat's. With buildings that are older we have had and will continue to have expenses with the electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems.

Our Parish has been blessed with the services of many volunteers who receive no compensation. Some of our buildings including both of our beautiful churches are cleaned by volunteers. All of our office and professional accounting staff are also non-paid volunteers. Many others provide important services such as working our Fish Frys and other Parish activities. Thus far we have been able to operate with a very limited staff. Let us together thank God for the generosity of so many and pray that St. Katharine Drexel Parish will continue to be a blessing for so many.

Queridos amigos en Cristo:

Con mucha gratitud a Dios y a ustedes, presentamos un resumen de la actividad financiera 2018-2019 de la Parroquia St. Katharine Drexel. Hemos sido bendecidos al terminar nuestro año fiscal con una nota muy positiva. Los feligreses y los visitantes donaron generosamente para apoyar las necesidades básicas de nuestra parroquia. Nuestros eventos para recaudar fondos tuvieron bastante éxito debido a los esfuerzos de tantos voluntarios y participantes.

Mirando hacia el futuro, sin embargo, todavía tenemos muchos retos que requerirán fondos adicionales. Hemos sido bendecidos con los servicios de un director musical. Hemos agregado su salario y beneficios a nuestro presupuesto.

Tenemos muchas instalaciones maravillosas para atender a los feligreses y disfrutar de las actividades parroquiales. Sin embargo, estas instalaciones tienen infraestructuras antiguas que requieren atención. La Iglesia de San Patricio pronto necesitará un techo nuevo. Además, la mayoría de nuestros edificios necesitan algunos apuntalamientos y otros trabajos externos para garantizar su longevidad útil y para mejorar la eficiencia de los servicios públicos. Desde el 1 de julio, hemos podido reconstruir las escaleras exteriores de escape para incendios en el Centro Parroquial, así como las dos escaleras externas traseras de San Patricio. Con edificios tan antiguos, tenemos y seguiremos teniendo en nuestros gastos las reparaciones de los sistemas eléctricos, de plomería y de climatización.

Nuestra parroquia ha sido bendecida con los servicios de voluntarios que no reciben ninguna compensación. Algunos de nuestras edificaciones, incluidas nuestras dos hermosas iglesias, son limpiadas por voluntarios. Todo nuestro personal administrativo y contable profesional también está integrado por voluntarios no remunerados. Muchos otros brindan servicios importantes como trabajar en el "Pescado Frito" y en otras actividades parroquiales. Hasta ahora hemos podido operar con un personal muy limitado. Demos juntos gracias a Dios por la generosidad de tantos y recemos para que la parroquia St. Katharine Drexel continúe siendo una bendición para muchos.
