

WASHING OUR NEIGHBOR'S FEET

As we commemorate the Last Supper, it is good to meditate on the meaning of the washing of the feet in relation to a call to discipleship. In March of 2019, I was getting close to completing *Retreat in Daily Life (RIDL)** when I wrote a meditation on John 13:1-17, "The Washing of the Feet". I imagined myself as Simon Peter, the one who protests "You will never wash my feet". Jesus answered him, "Unless I wash you, you will have no inheritance with me." At this invitation, Simon insists now that Jesus must wash not only his feet, but his hands and head as well. By this meditation Jesus was teaching me how true discipleship requires that kind of extreme humility to serve my neighbors, even the least of my brothers.

Fr. Shay Cullen SSC writes in *Reflection---The Last Supper* (www.columban.org.au E-News-Vol.4 No.3): "During the Eucharist we are called to be true and faithful disciples-to be another Christ." Father explains that Jesus intended to shock his disciples when he washed their feet to give them and us this model of an unselfish servant. By his example, we are expected to commit ourselves to washing our neighbor's feet by helping the poor and downtrodden, releasing captives, healing the sick, and challenging the causes of poverty and oppression. In the Eucharist, instituted during the Last Supper, we receive not only the spiritual power to embrace these commitments, but also the courage to act for and on behalf of the abused, oppressed, the sick, and the hungry.

Fr. Cullen reminds us, "When Jesus told his disciples and followers to 'Do this in memory of me,' it wasn't just a sentimental ritual he left, but a memorial of his life, death, and resurrection." Let us be ever mindful as we participate in the Eucharist, that this is the moment when Christ is fully present in our midst, inspiring and sustaining us to preach his Word and fulfill his mission by bending down and washing our neighbor's feet.

Lest we forget, Fr. Cullen leaves us with this final thought. When we break the bread and drink the cup in the Eucharist, above all, we encounter the living presence of Christ and pledge our lives to transform the world one neighbor at a time.
