## MOST SACRED ACT OF WORSHIP: OBLIGATION OR PRIVILEGE?

The Facebook page of “Love Being Catholic” posted an essay on June 27, 2021 which makes a rock-solid case to prove that, “The Mass is the most important and sacred act of worship in the Catholic Church”. The author skillfully backs up this statement using language which is both convincing and reader friendly. The article begins with this concise description of the Sacred Mystery, “The Mass incorporates the Bible (Sacred Scripture), prayer, sacrifice, hymns, symbols, gestures, sacred food for the soul, and directions on how to live a Catholic life—all in one ceremony.” The remainder of the writing continues to explain the origins of this “Most Sacred Act of Worship” and why this act requires every Catholic to understand that Mass is not just an obligation, but it is a privilege we have been freely given.

We know that the Last Supper was the first Mass Jesus celebrated with His disciples. After His Ascension into heaven, each Mass would become a re-creation, a re-enactment, a re-presentation of the Last Supper, but not a re-sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary. It would become the central form of worship in the early Church, as Christ had commanded when He said, “Do this in remembrance of me” (Luke 22:19). Two thousand years later, Catholics join together “to be made present in Christ’s timeless sacrifice for our sins” at every celebration of the Lord’s Supper around the world.

As Catholics we should know that the first of the 5 Precepts of the Church states: “You shall attend Mass on Sunday and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor”. If you are like me and need to refresh your memory, I suggest you Google “5 Precepts of the Church”. They are the very basic rules which we are all obliged to obey. The author points out that many Catholics do not fulfill this First Precept because they do not understand the requirement or perhaps because they take for granted what is actually happening on the altar. If we read, study, pray and seek to understand more, we will fall in love with the *Eucharist* and we will want to go to Mass every day. Next week, we will learn more about why “Attending Mass (‘the most important and sacred act of worship in the Catholic Church’) is not just an obligation, it’s a privilege.”
